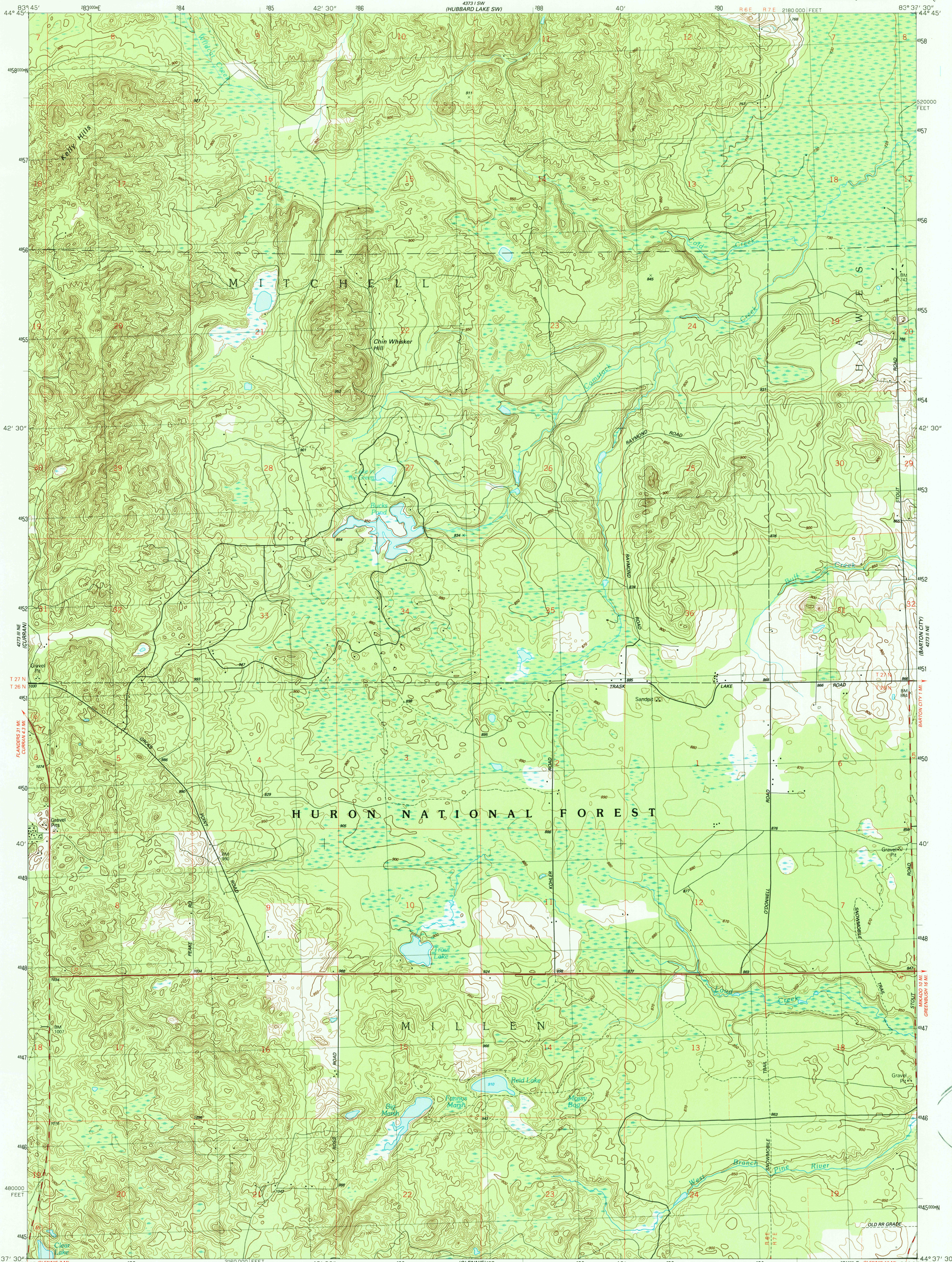

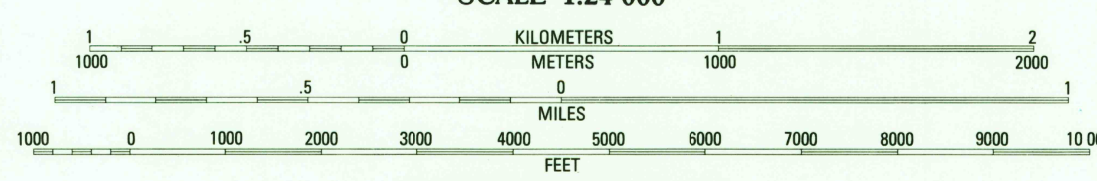
Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1958. Revised from aerial photographs taken 1983-84. Field checked 1988. Map edited 1989.

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983, move the projection lines 2 meters (north) and 4 meters (west) as shown by dashed corner ticks.

There may be private holdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map.

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked.
