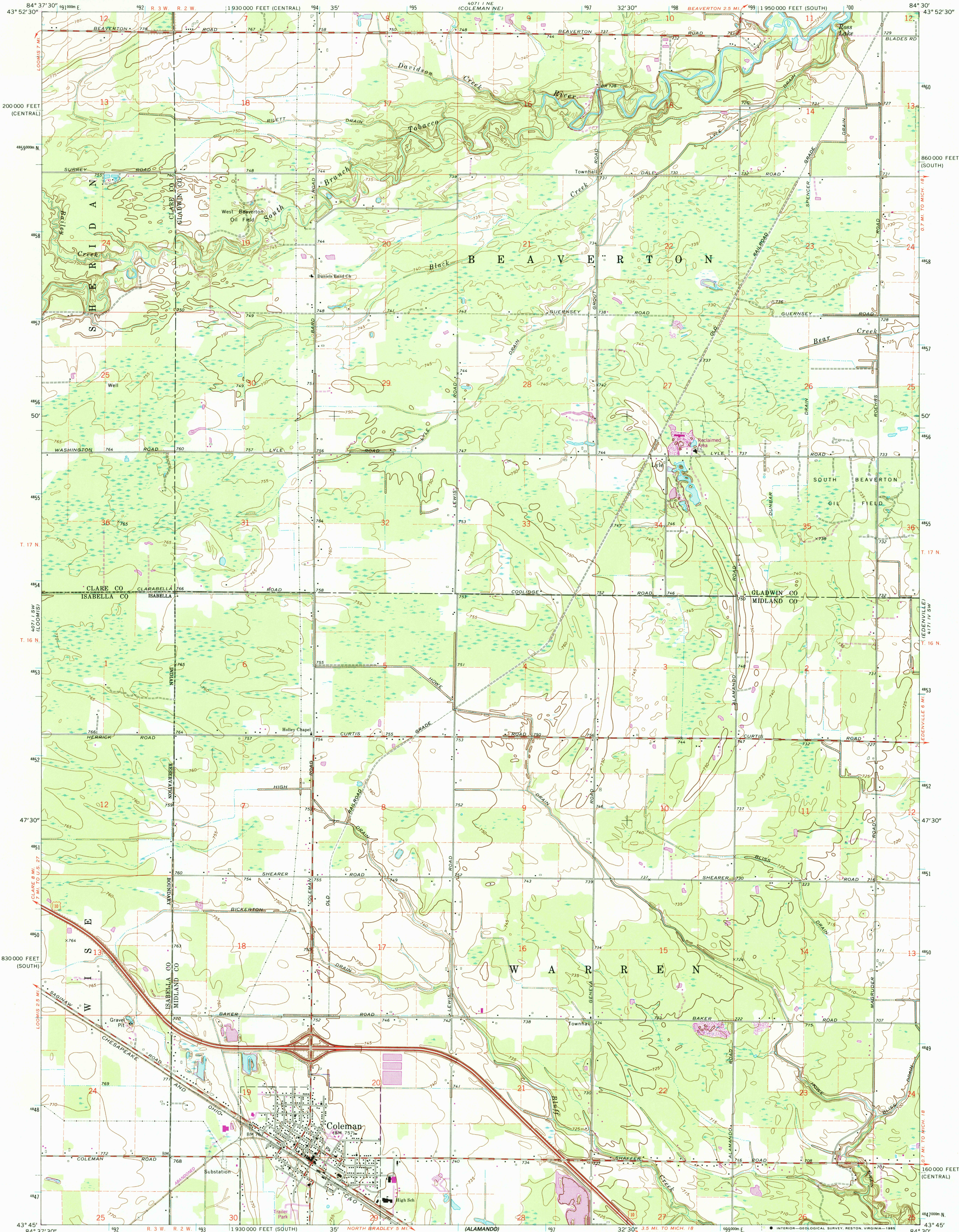

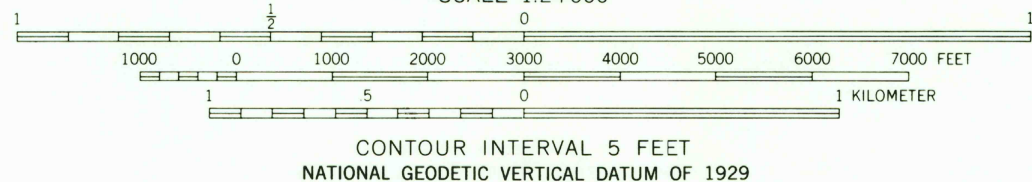
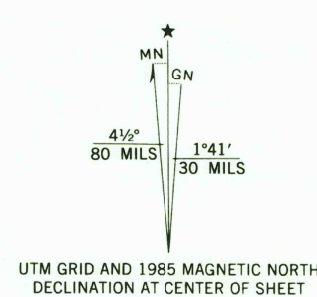

10,000-foot grids based on Michigan coordinate system,
south and central zones
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,
zone 16, shown in blue
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983,
move the projection lines 1 meter north and
2 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of
the National or State reservations shown on this map
