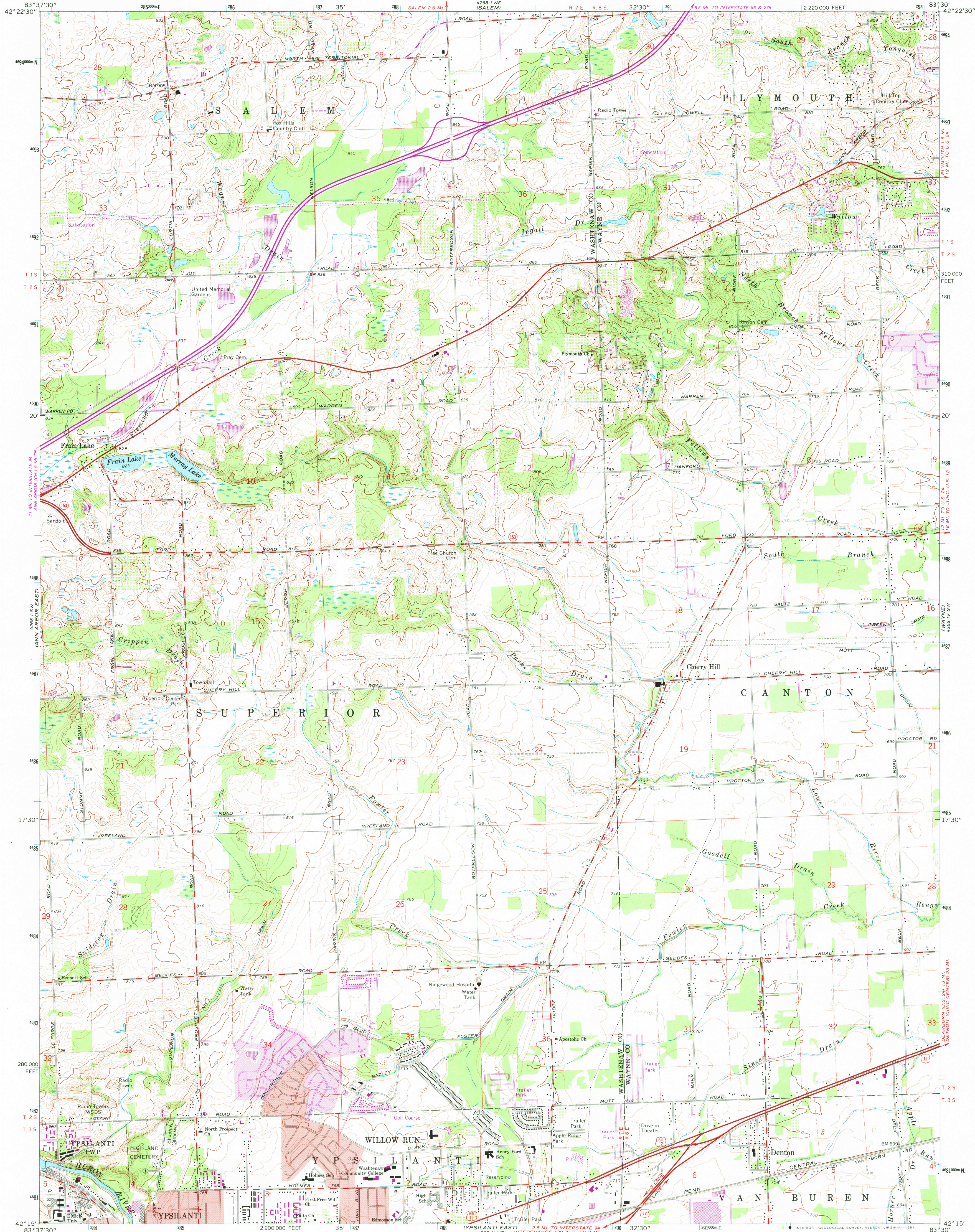

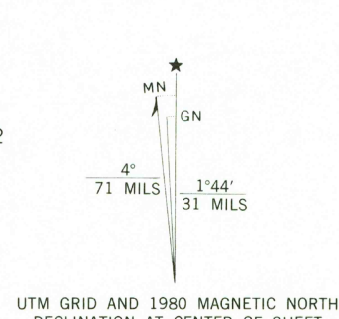

generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked

move the projection lines 6 meters west as shown by
