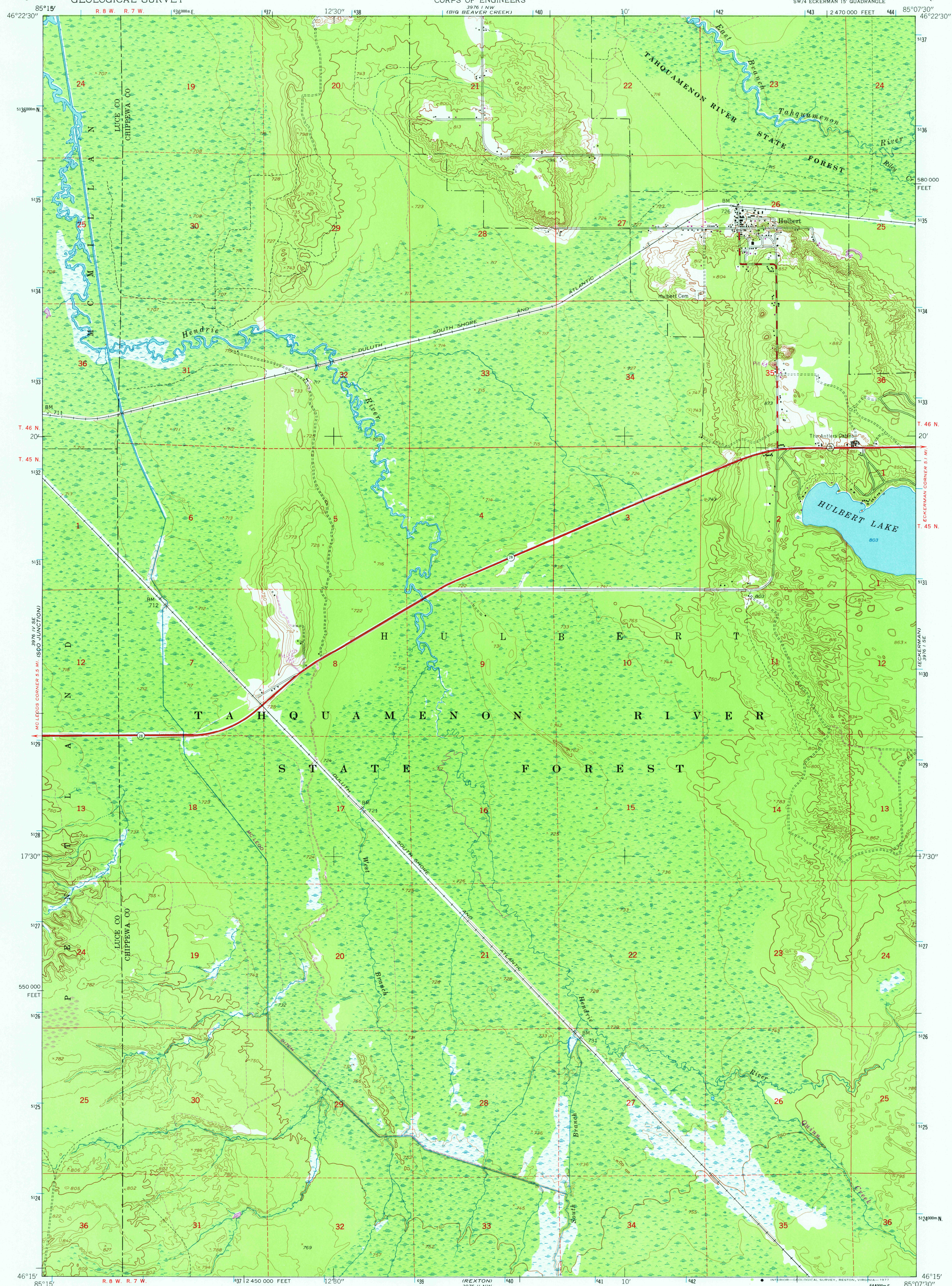

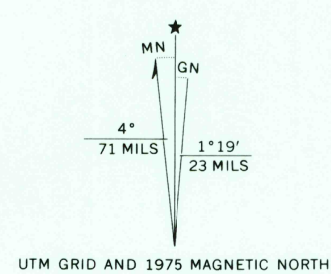
HULBERT QUADRANGLE
