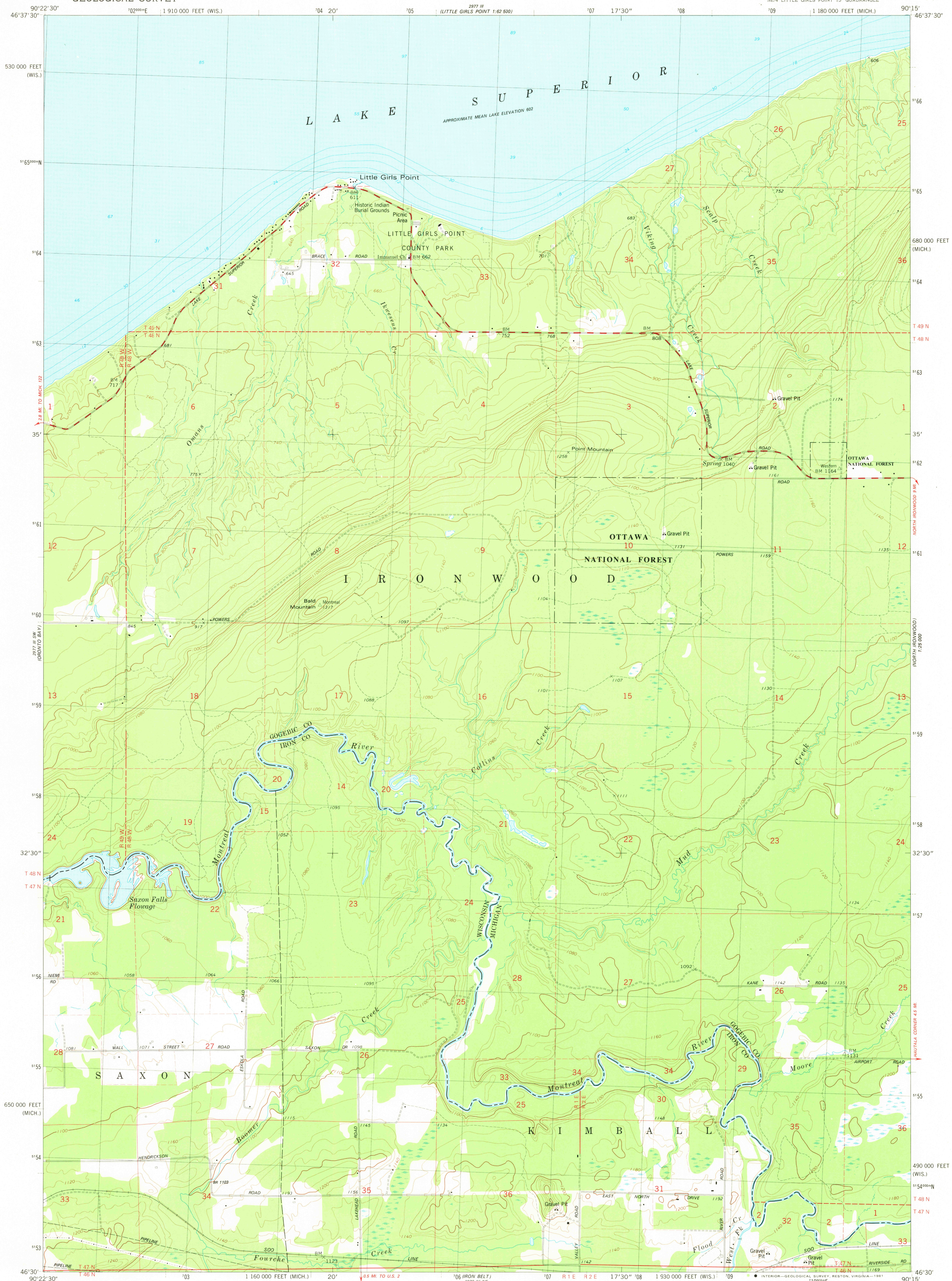

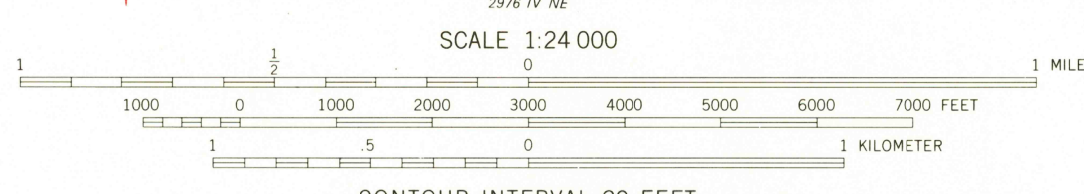
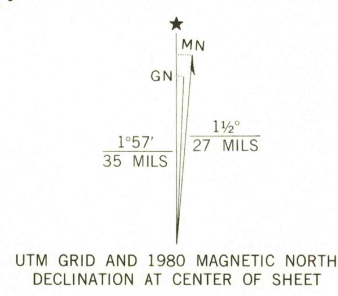
10,000-foot grid ticks based on Michigan coordinate system, north zone and Wisconsin coordinate system, north zone
