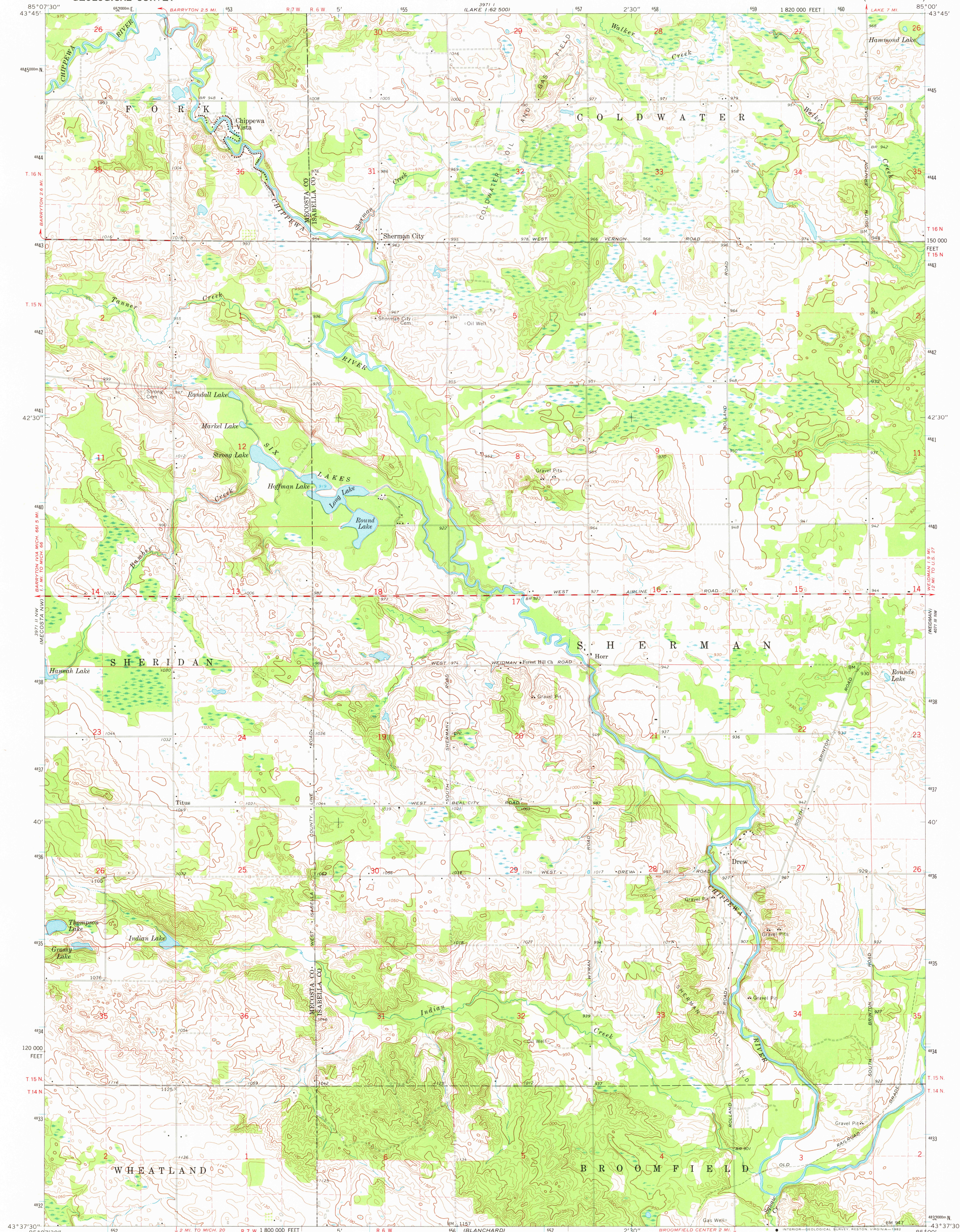

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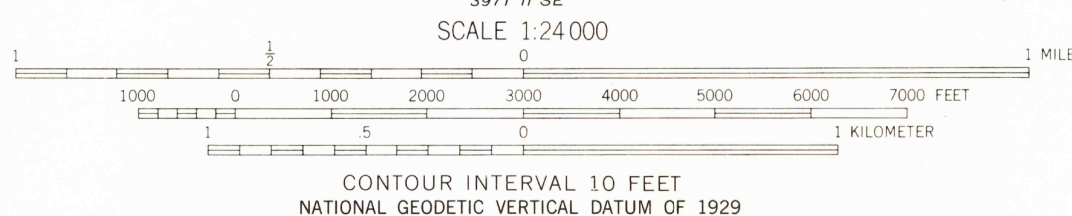
Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1963. Field checked 1964

move the projection lines 1 meter north and
1 meter east as shown by dashed corner ticks
