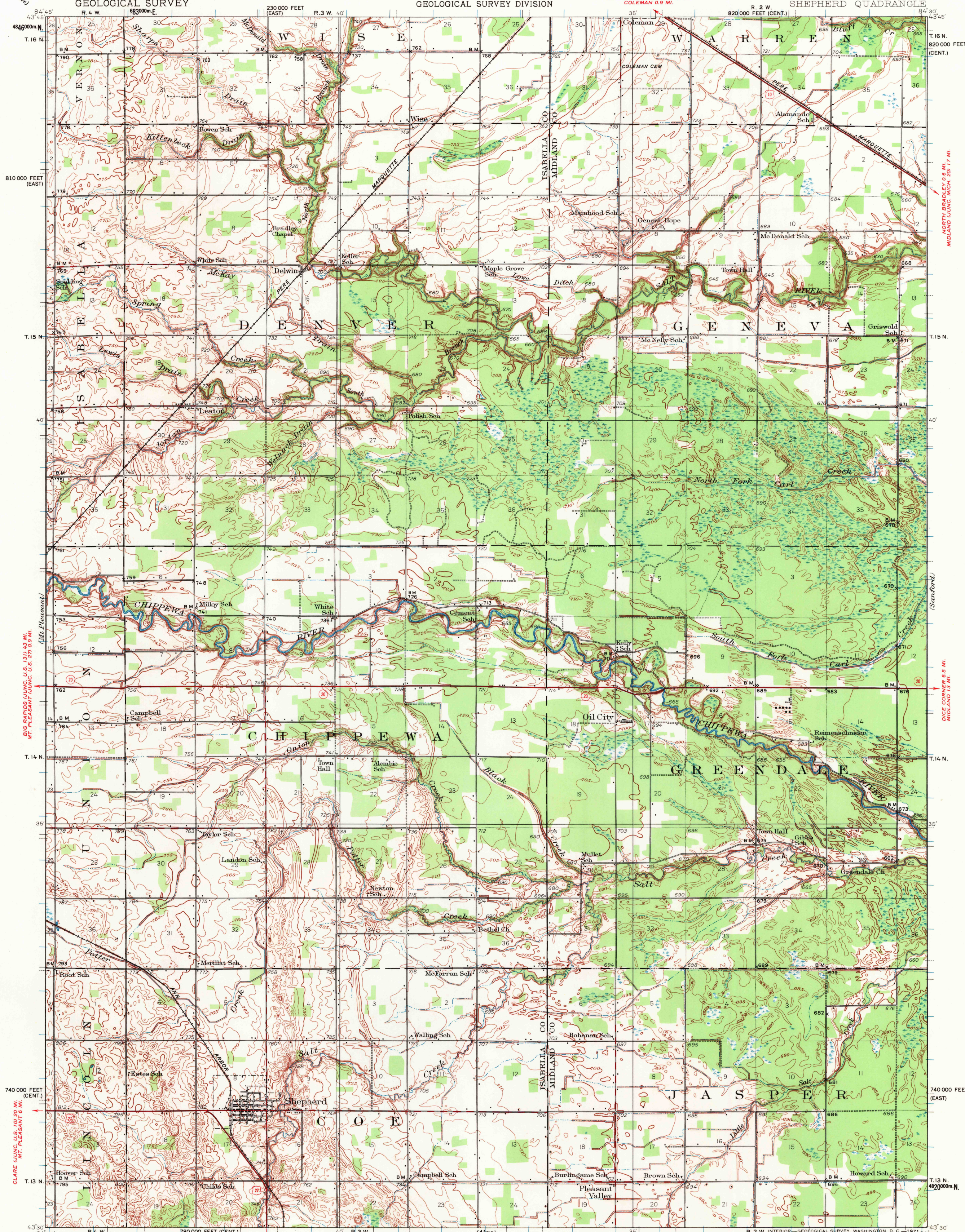

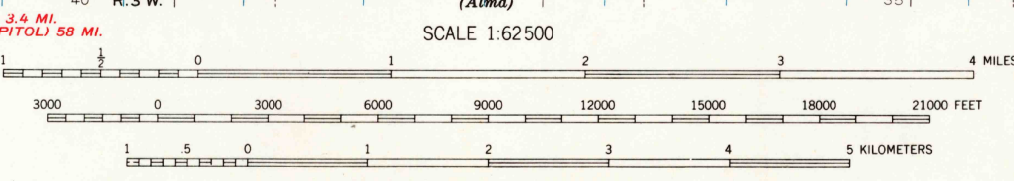
MICHIGAN
