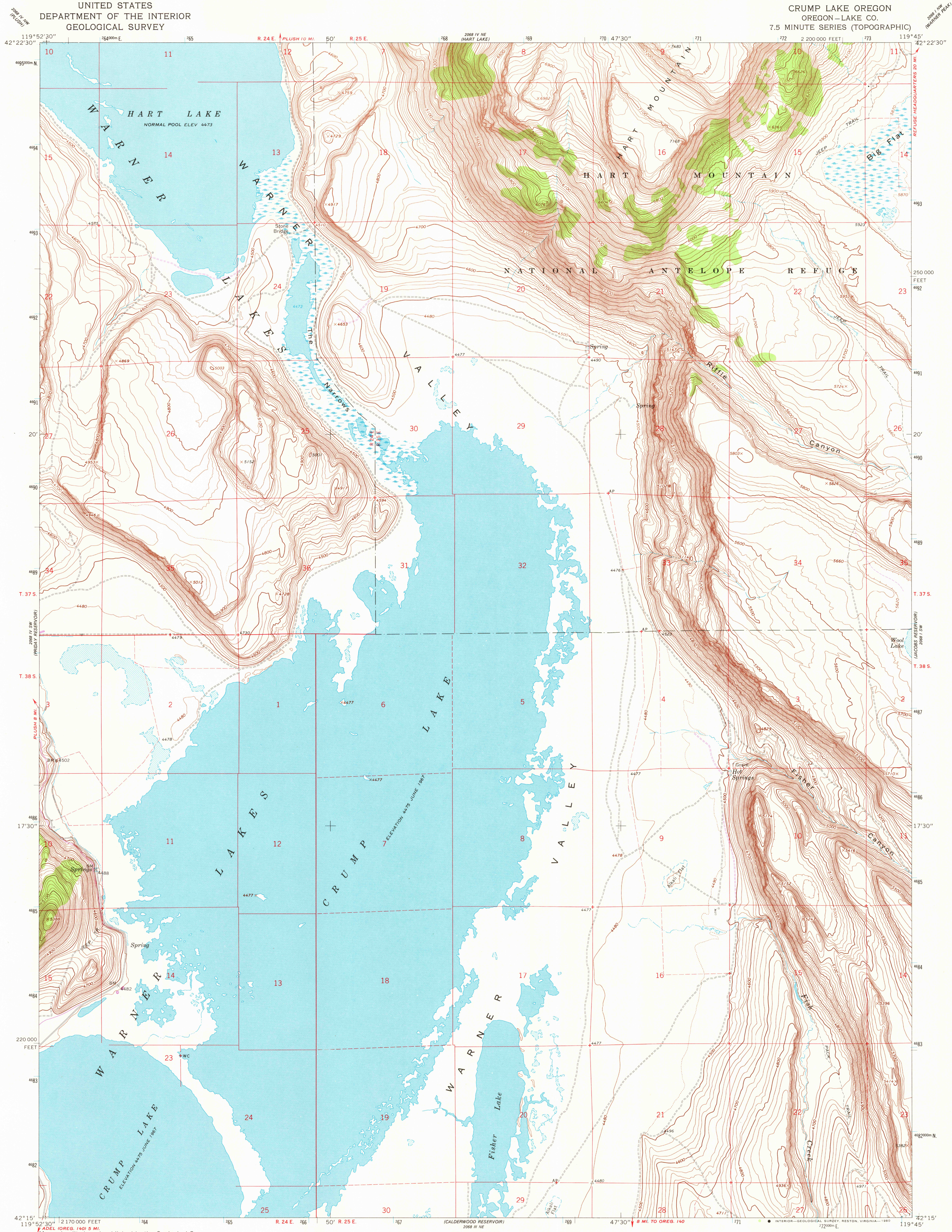

10,000-foot grid based on Oregon coordinate system, south zone

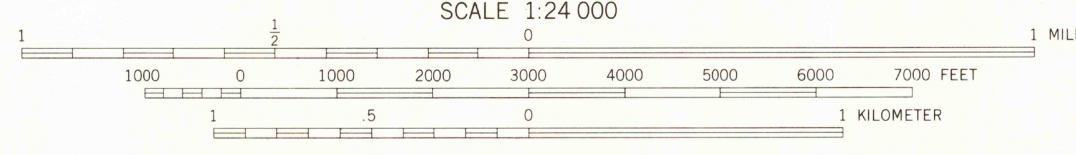
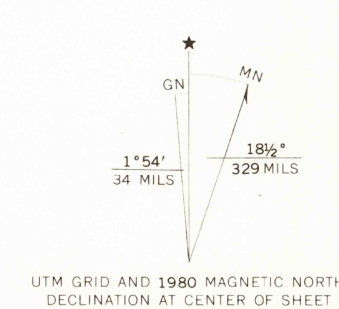
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 11, shown in blue
