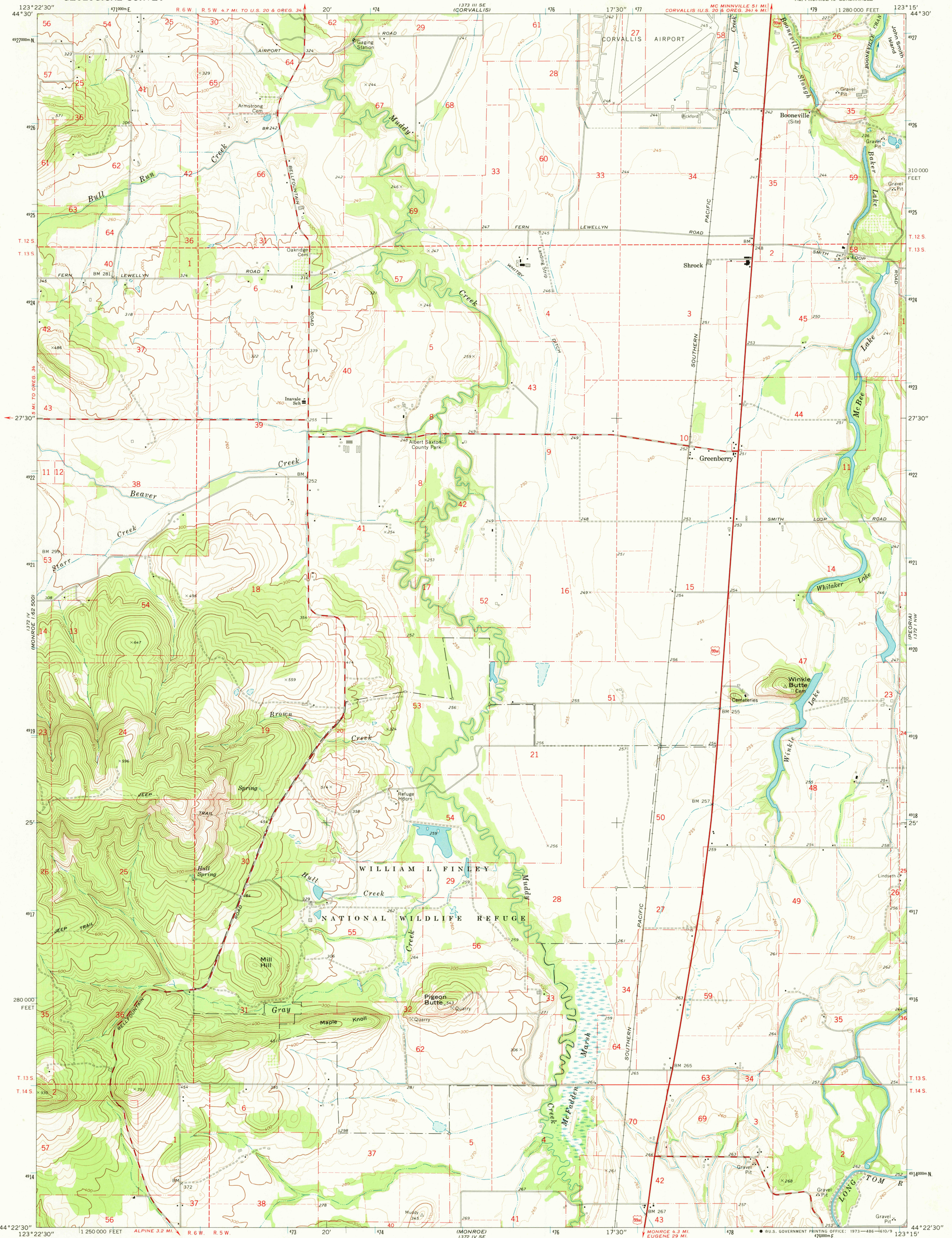

NE 1/4 MONROE 15' QUADRANGLE

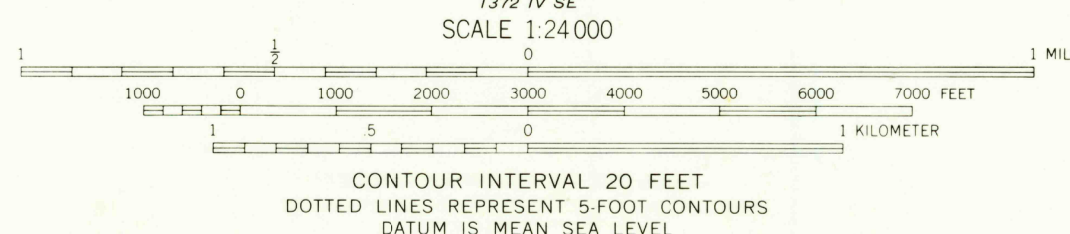
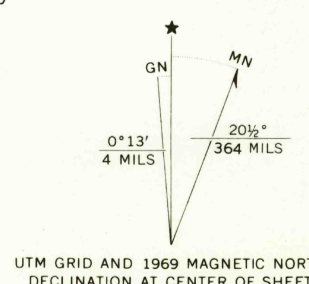
