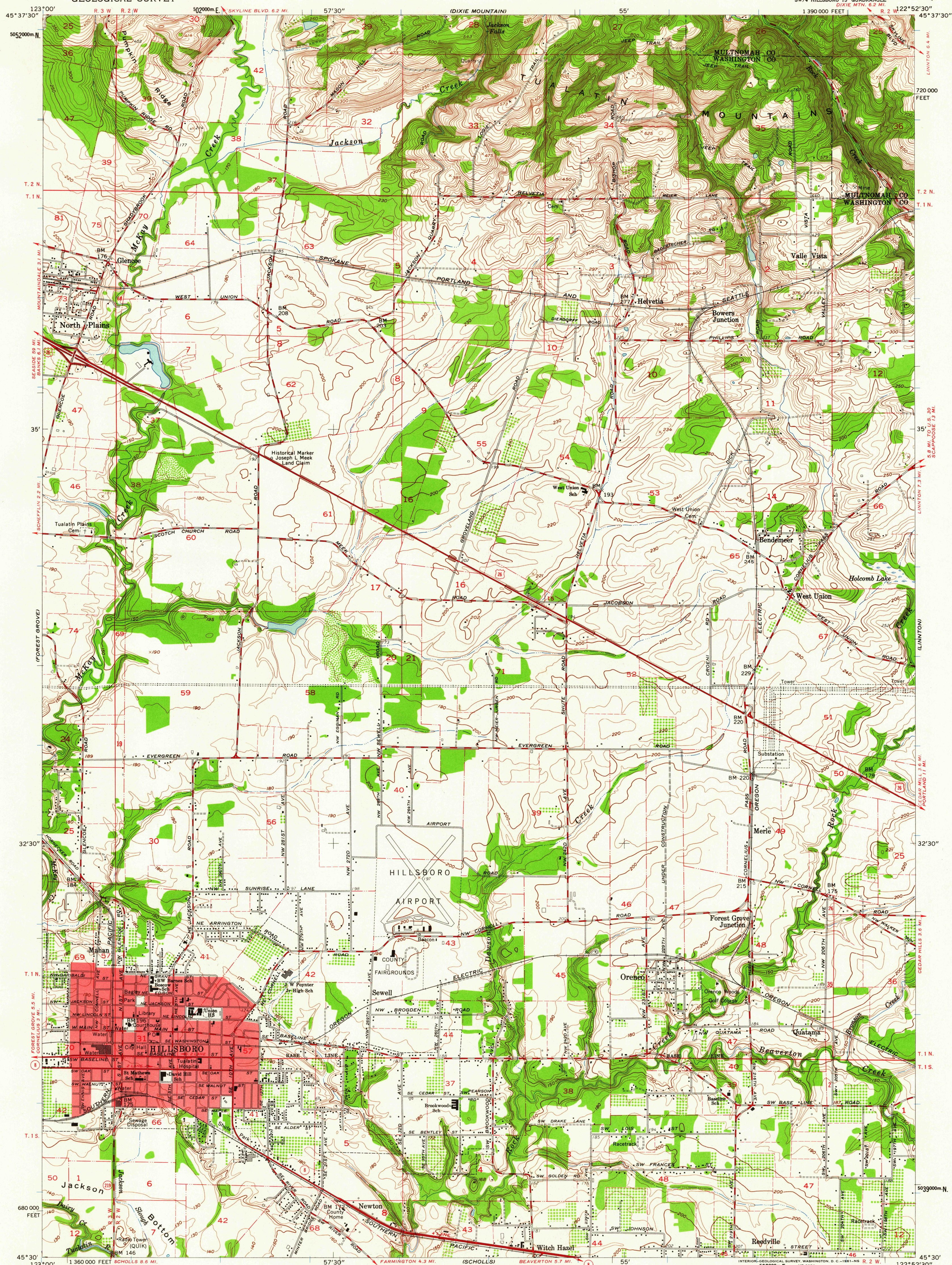

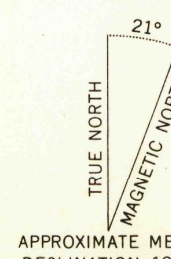
10,000-foot grid based on Oregon coordinate system, north zone

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,

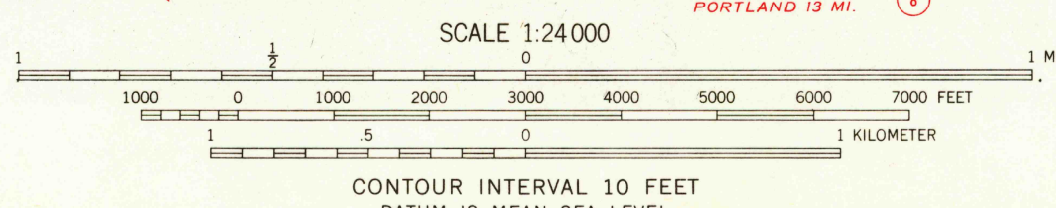
zone 10, shown in blue
