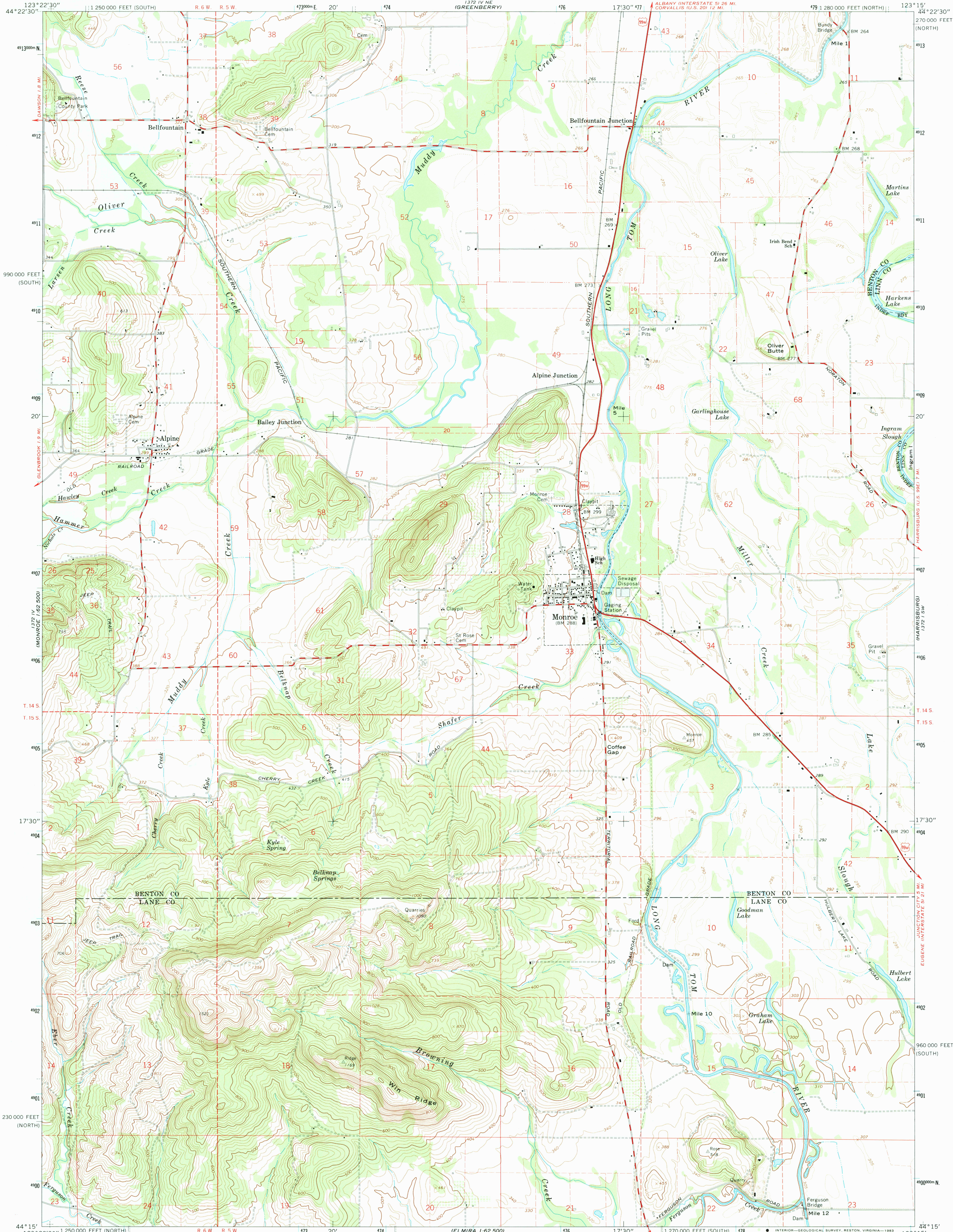

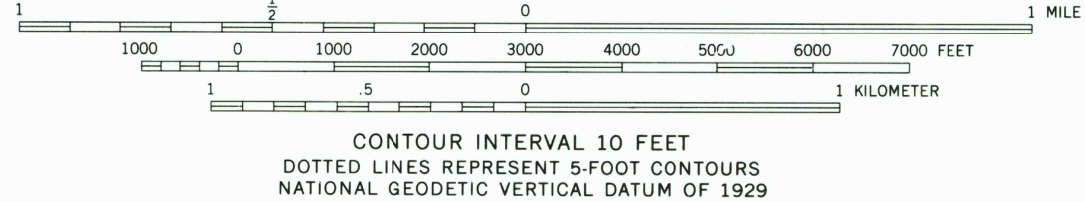
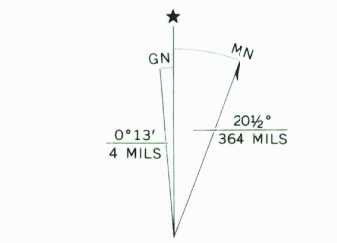

Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum. 10,000-foot grids based on Oregon coordinate system, north and south zones. 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 10, shown in blue.

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 23 meters north and 96 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks.

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines.
