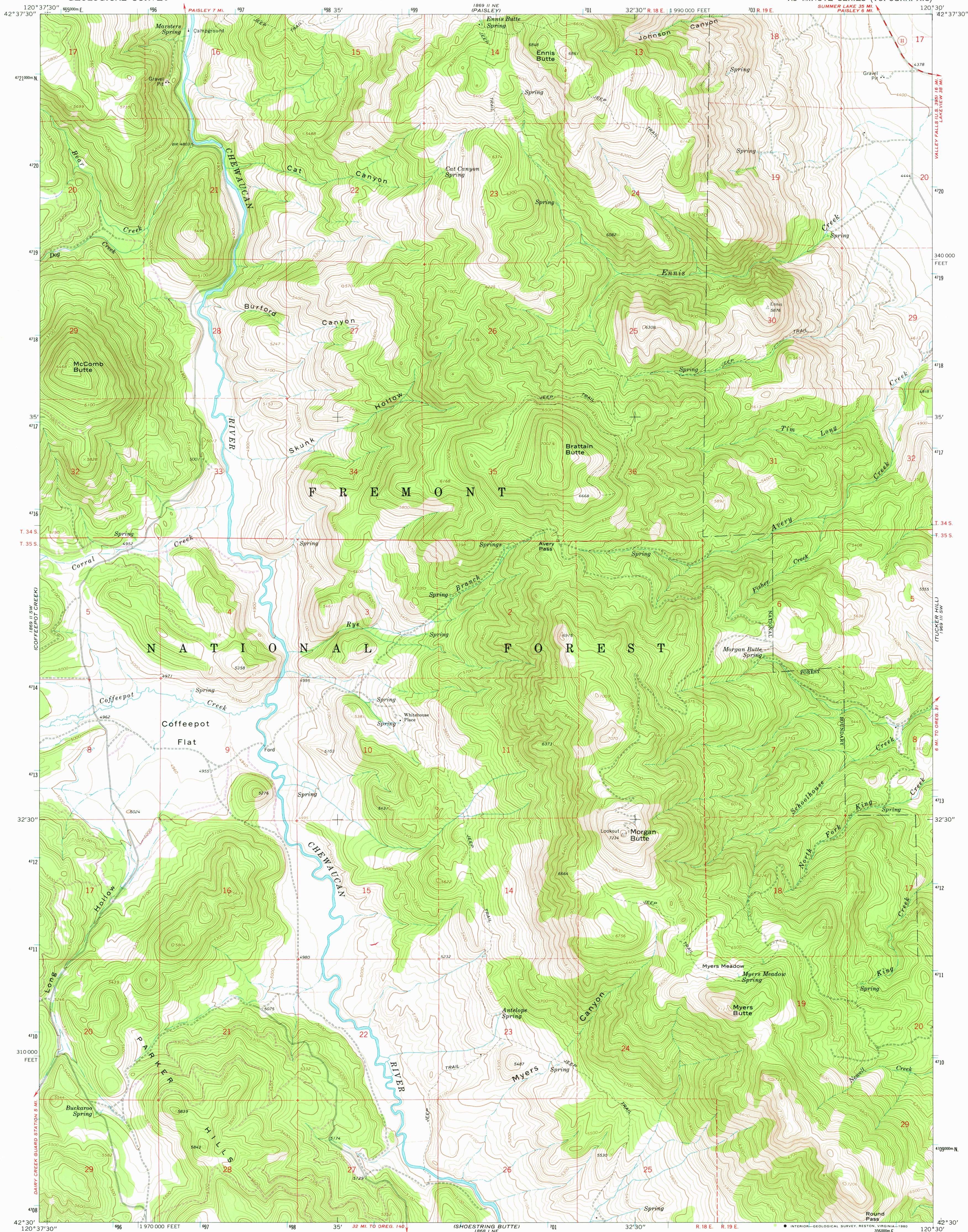

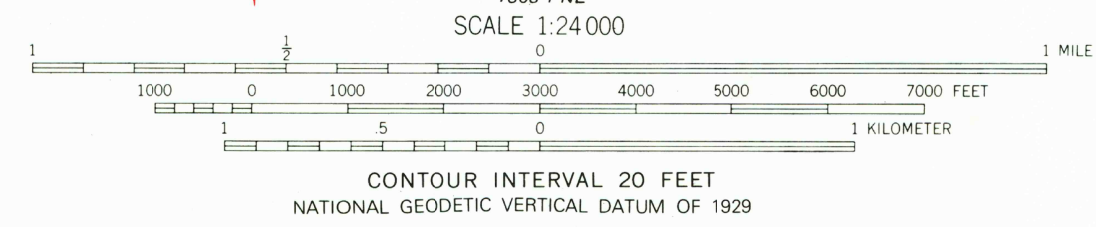
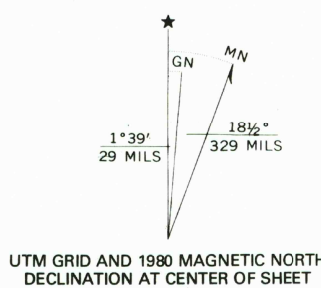
Polycyclic projection. 1927 North American datum 10,000-foot grid based on Oregon coordinate system, south zone

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 10, shown in blue

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 18 meters north and 90 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks

There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map
