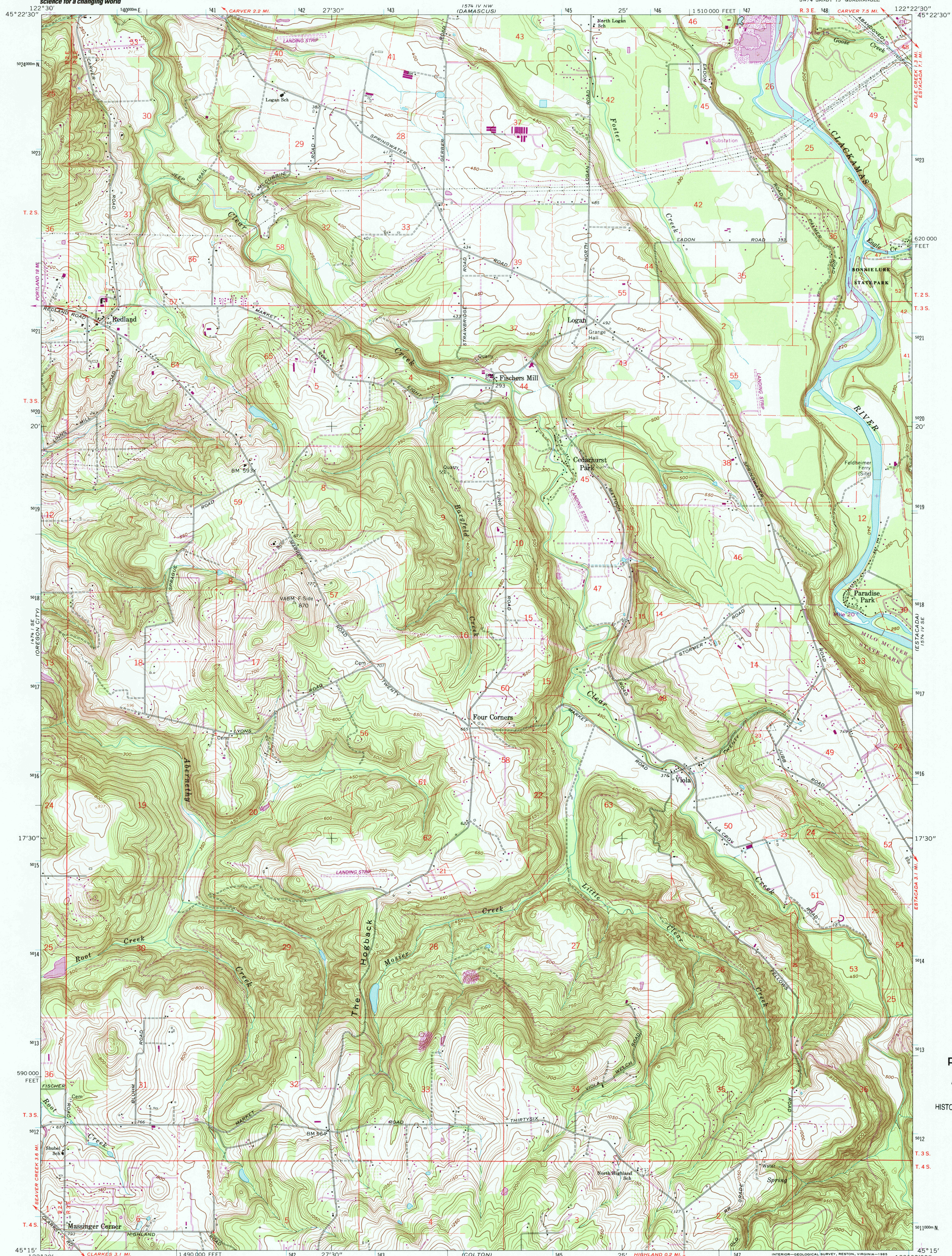

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 10, shown in blue

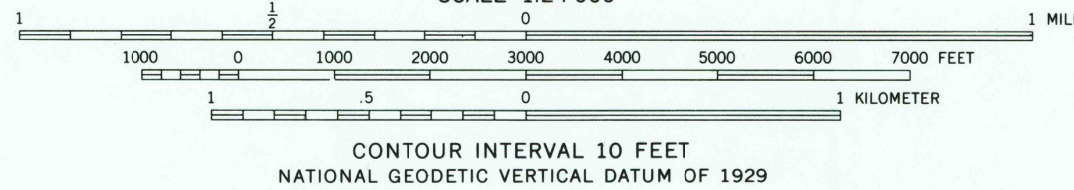
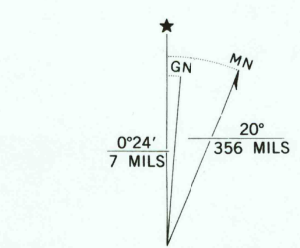
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983,
