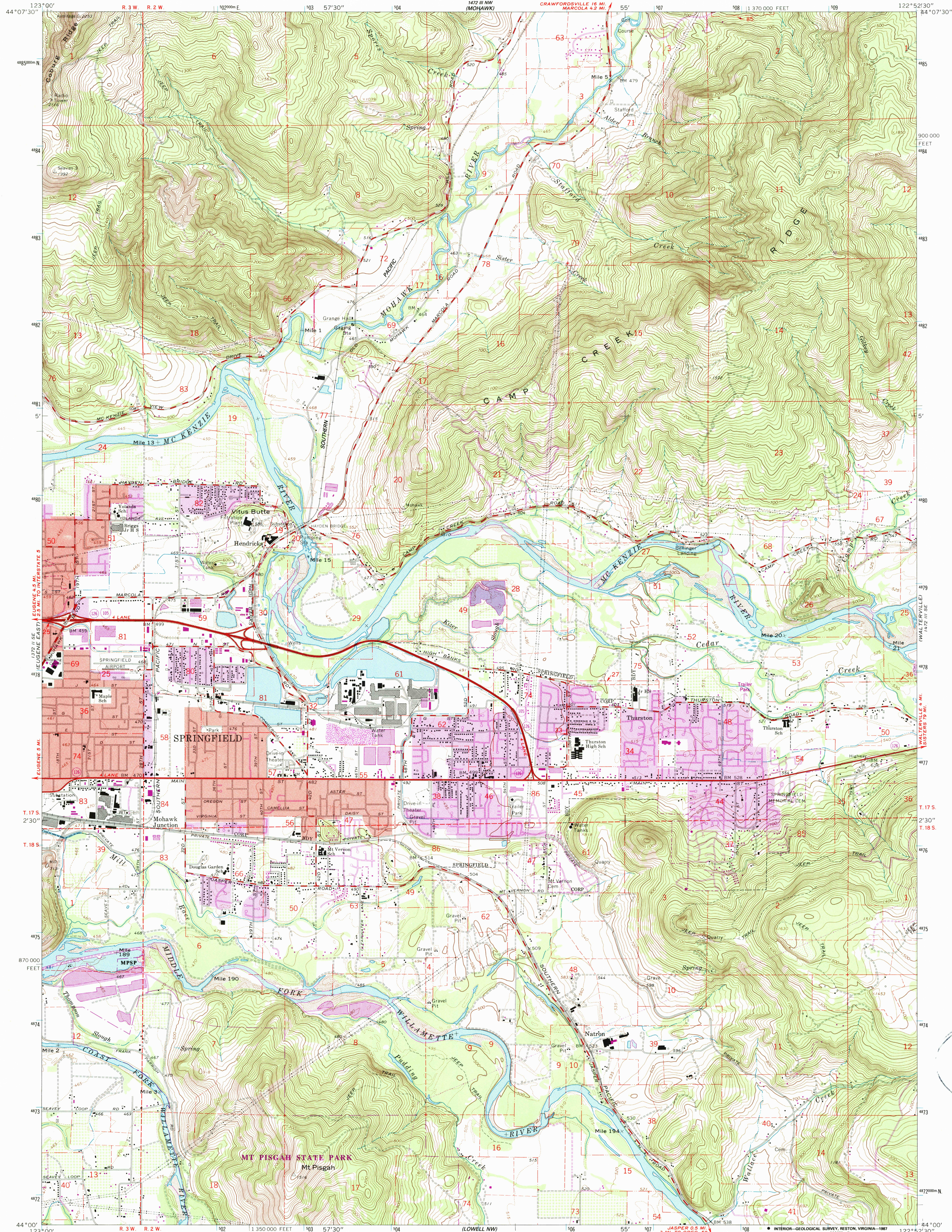

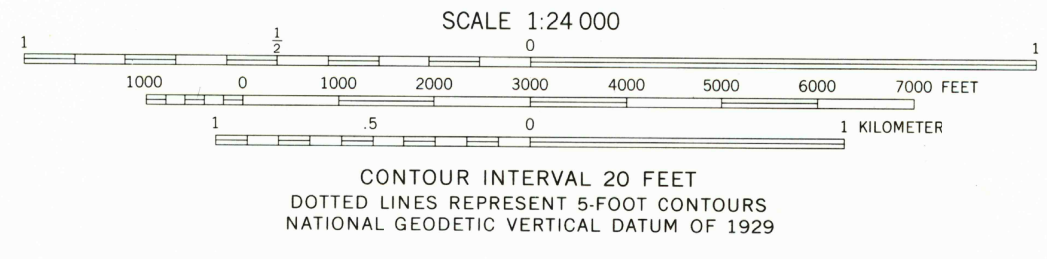
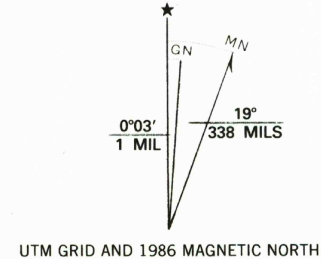
10,000 foot grid based on Oregon coordinate system, south zone
