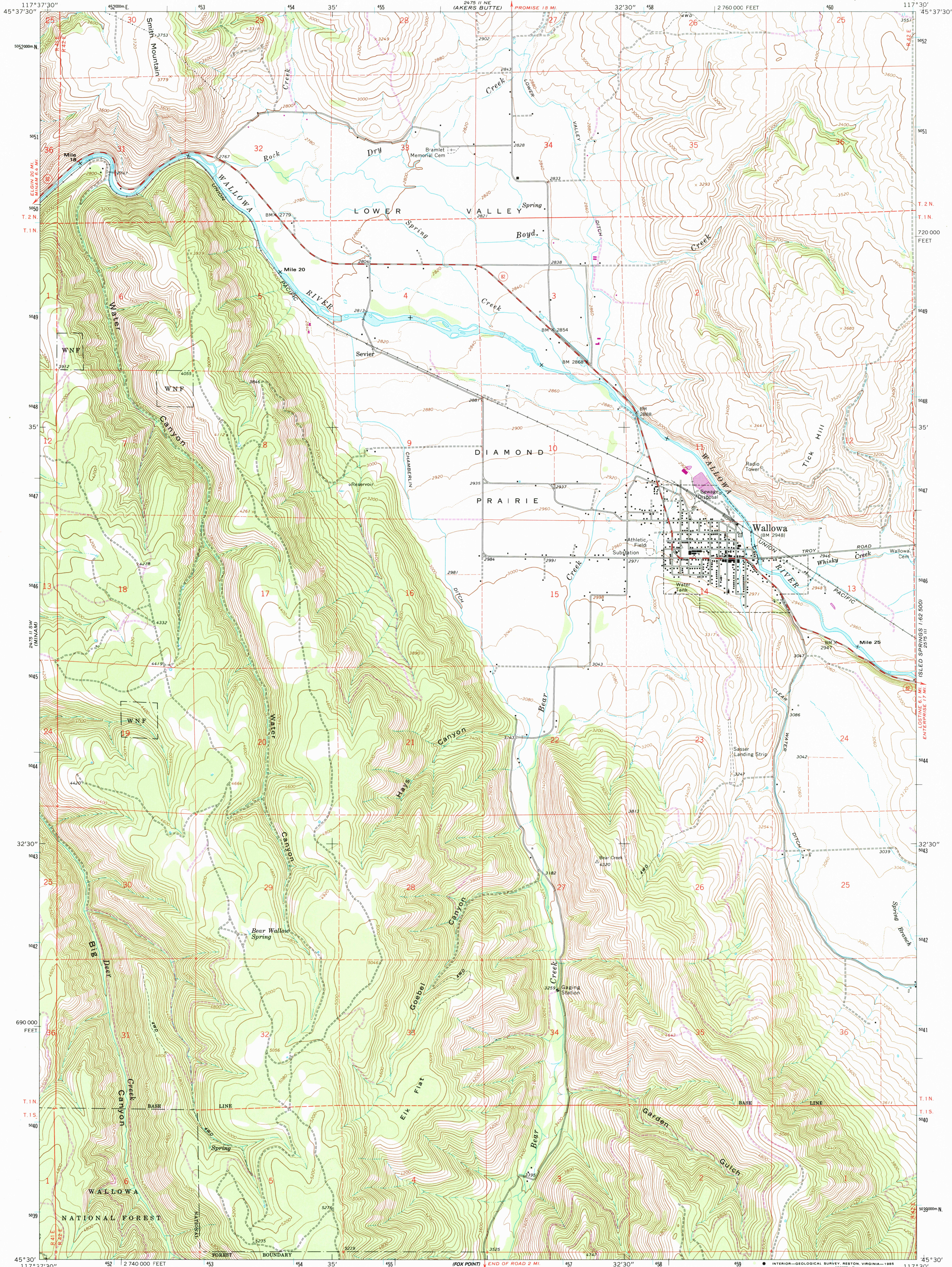

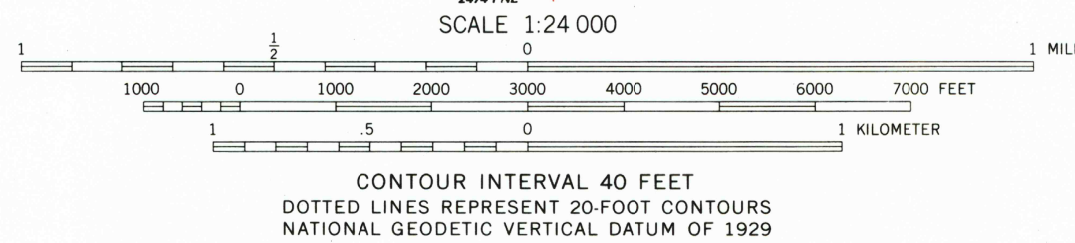
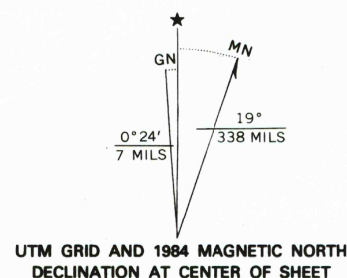
10,000-foot grid based on Oregon coordinate system, north zone
