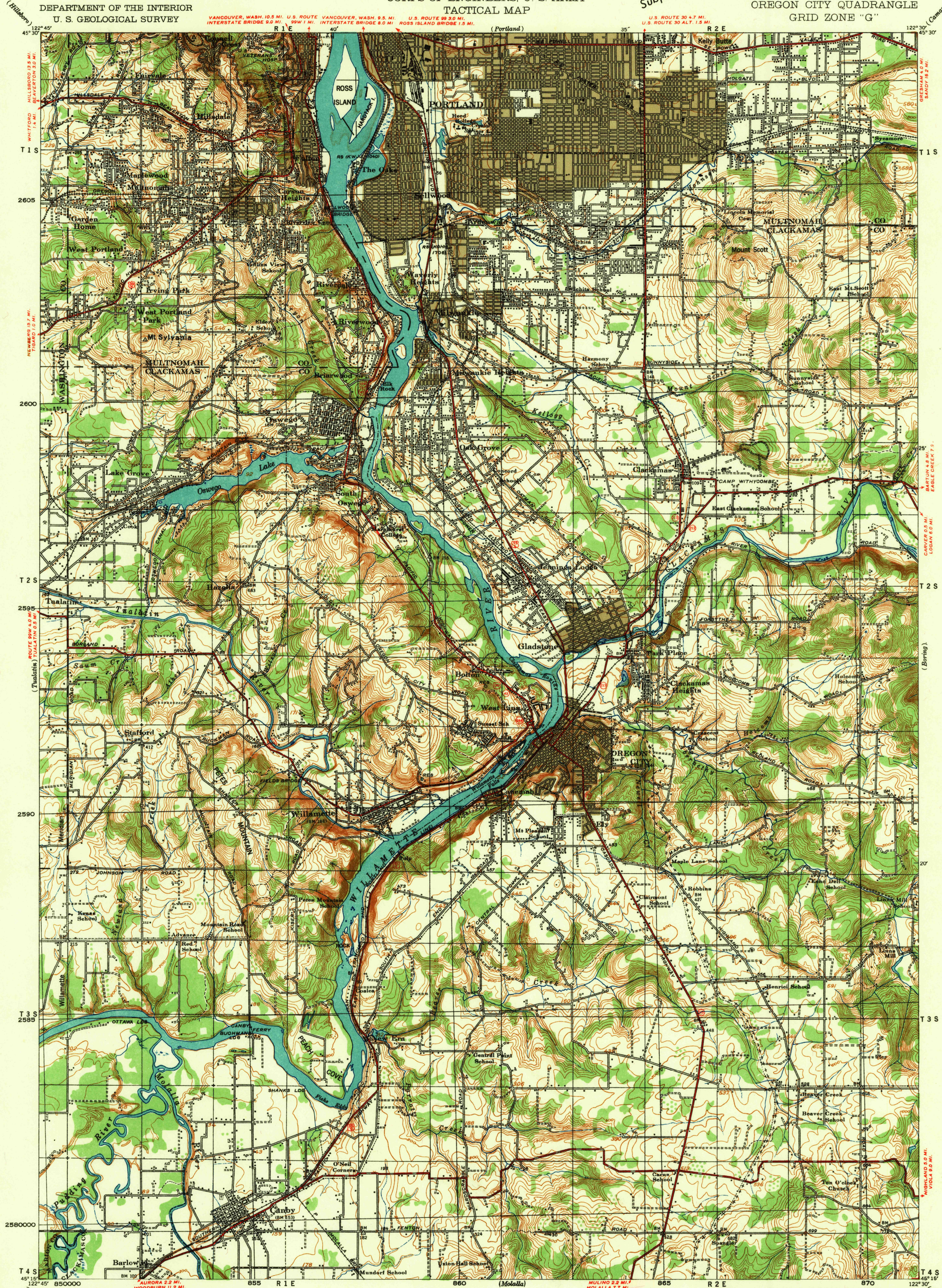

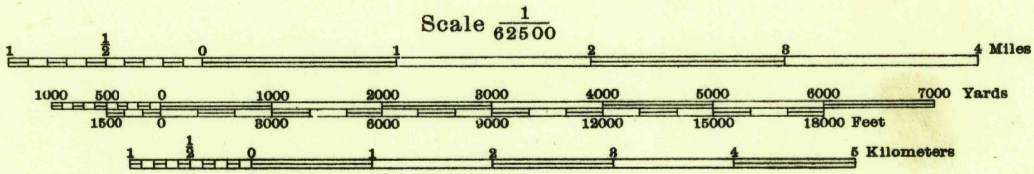

GRID ZONE "G"



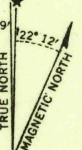
