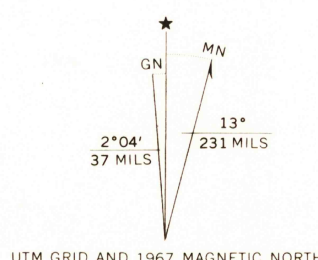

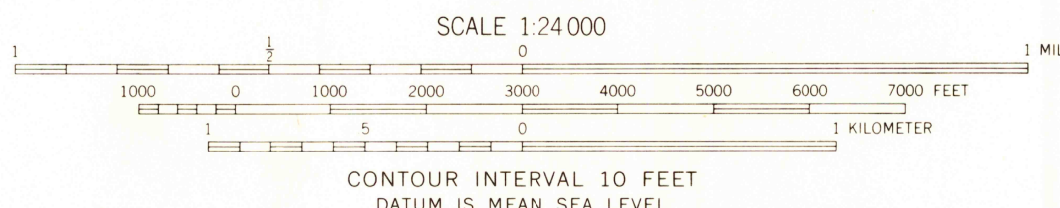

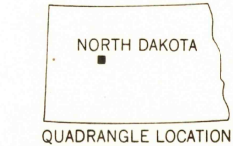


UTM GRID AND 1967 MAGNETIC NORTH
