

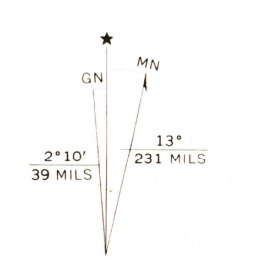

Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum 10,000-foot grids based on North Dakota coordinate system, north and south zones
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 14, shown in blue
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 4 meters north and 36 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
Map photinspected 1977
No major culture or drainage changes observed
