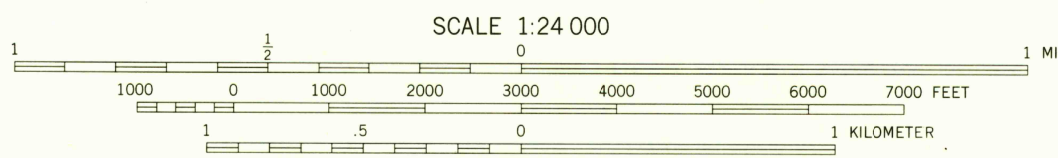
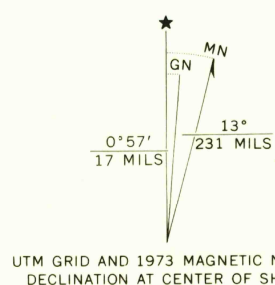

zone 13, shown in blue. 1927 North American datum

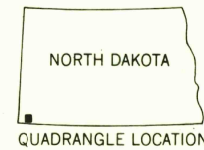
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines
