

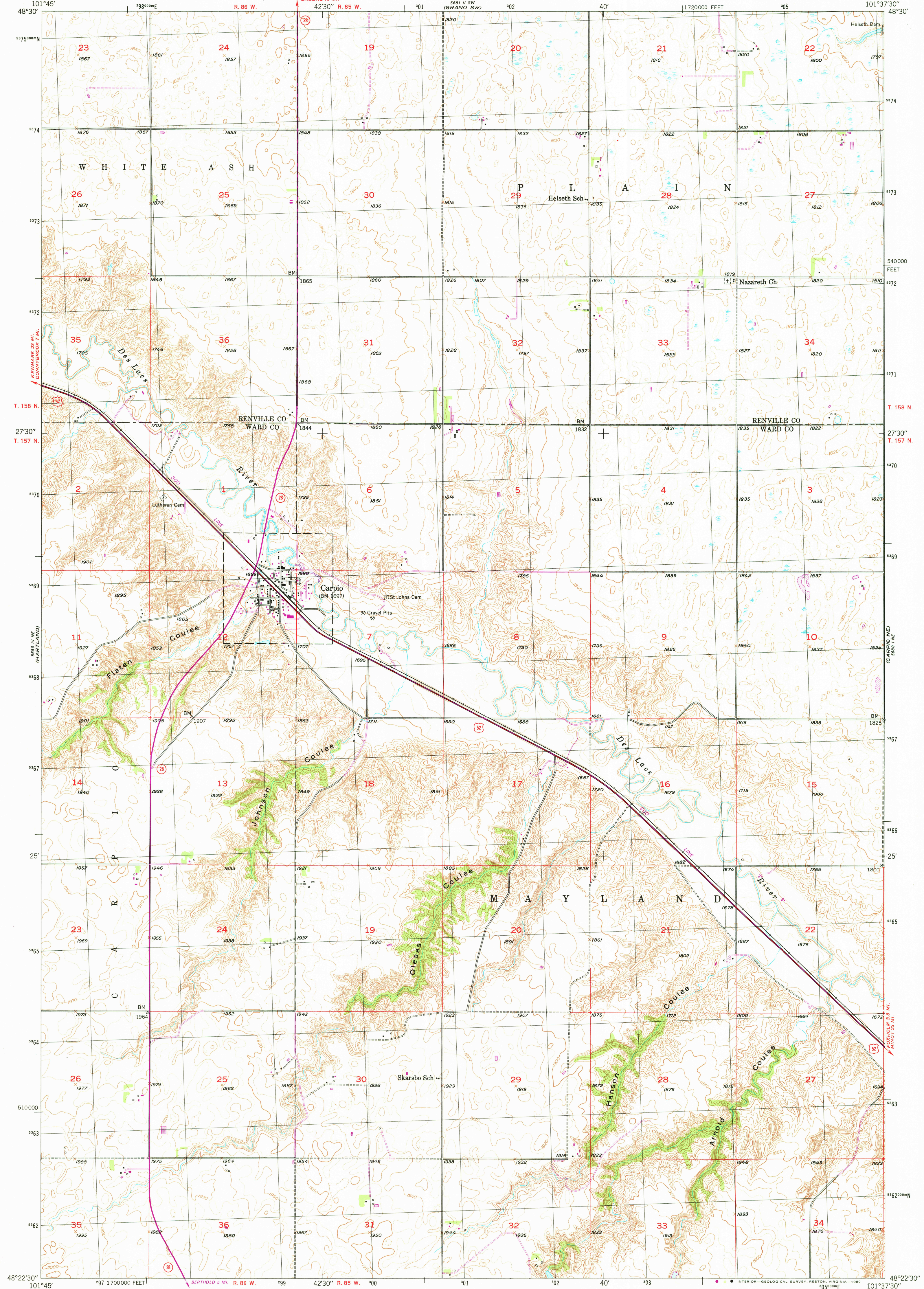

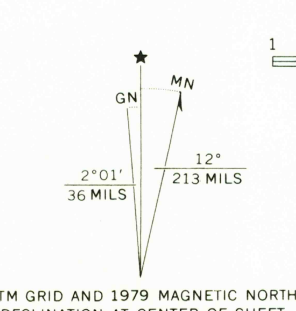


CARPIO QUADRANGLE

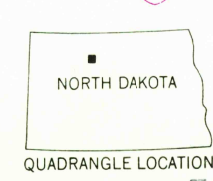
