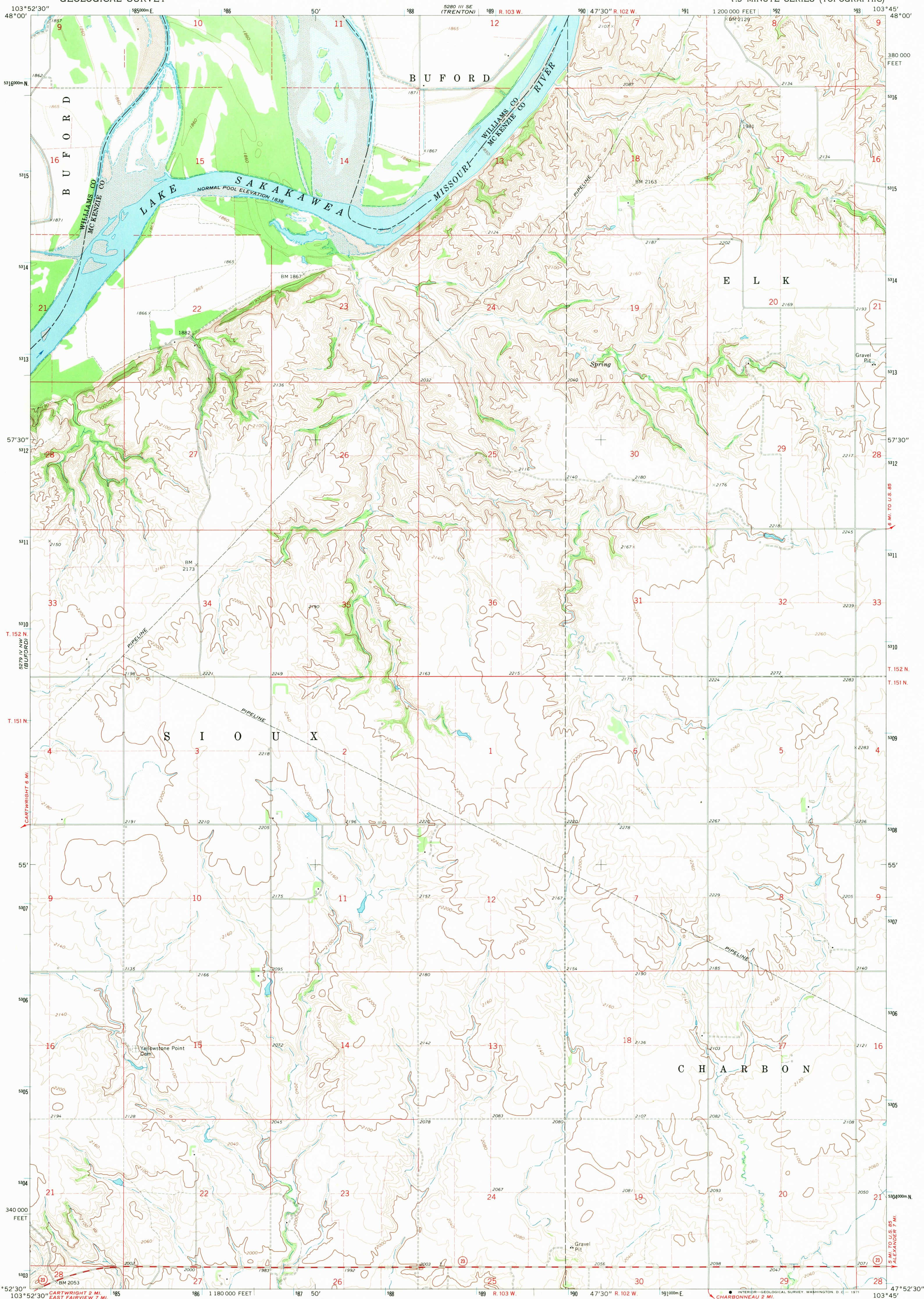
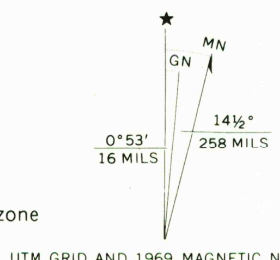

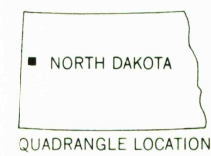
CARTWRIGHT NE QUADRANGLE

Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum. 10,000-foot grid based on North Dakota coordinate system, north zone 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 13, shown in blue. Areas covered by dashed light-blue pattern are subject to controlled inundation. Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs.
