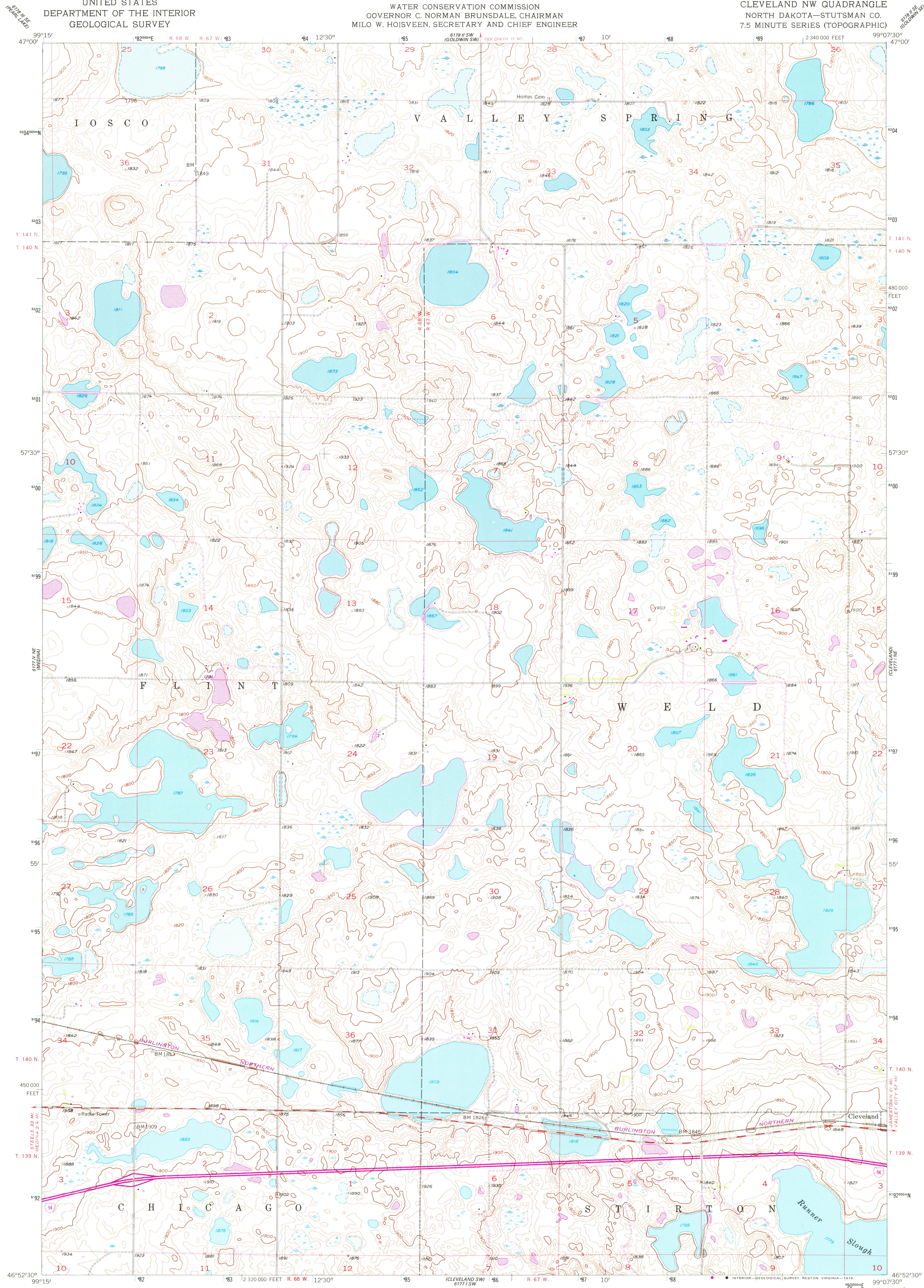

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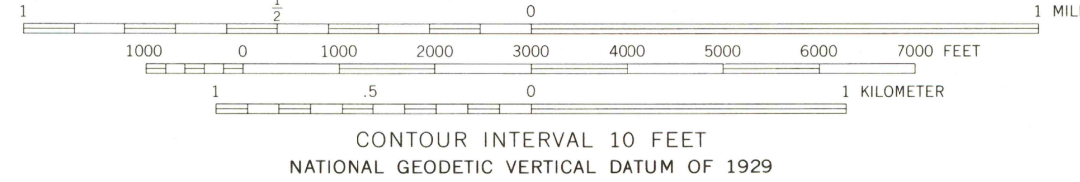
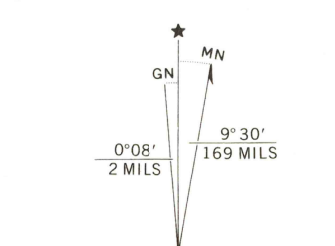
Culture and drainage in part compiled from aerial photographs taken 1951. Topography by planetable surveys 1954

Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum 10,000-foot grid based on North Dakota coordinate system, south zone

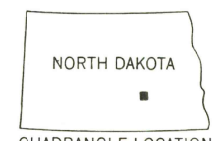
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 14, shown in blue
