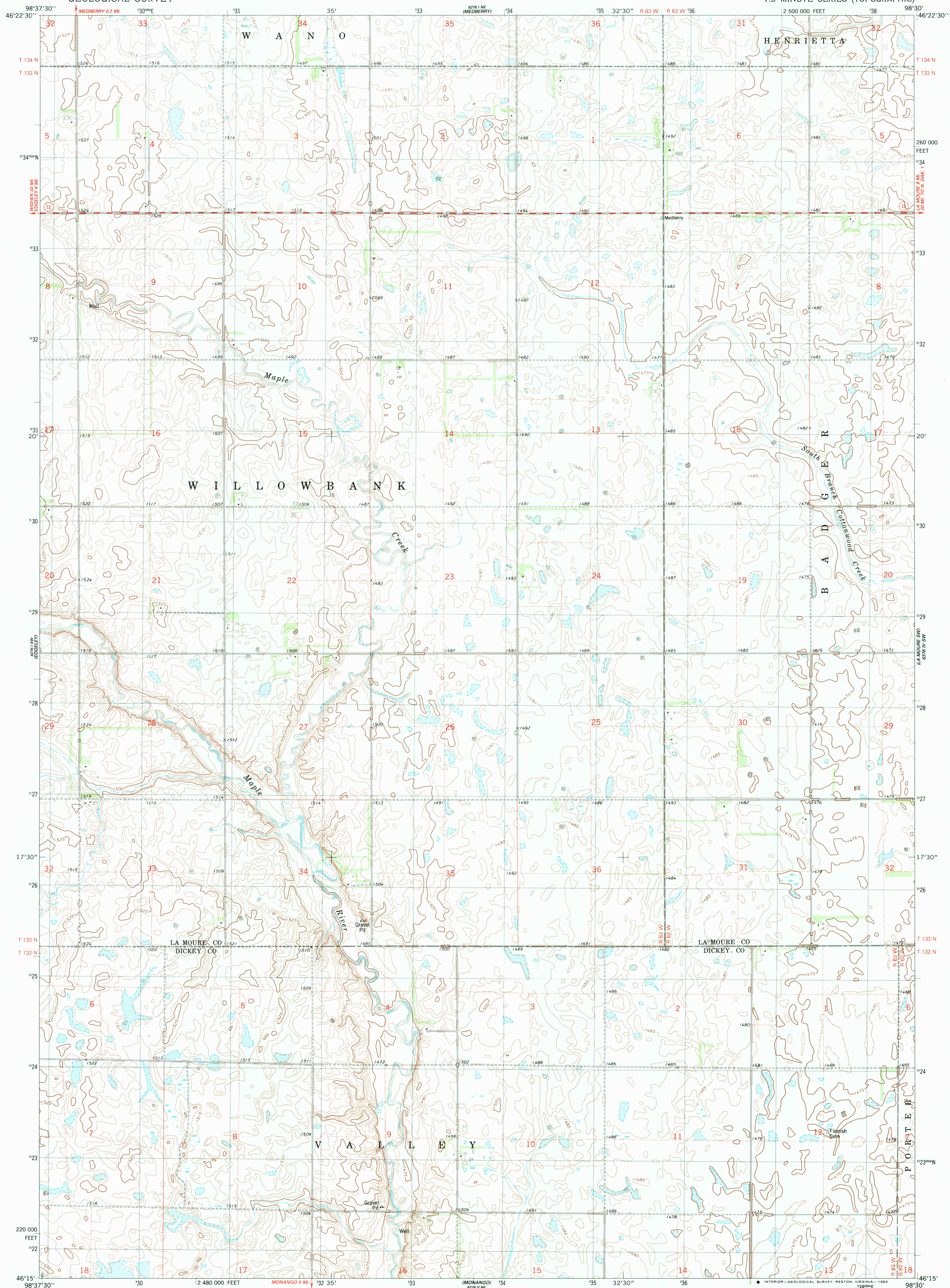

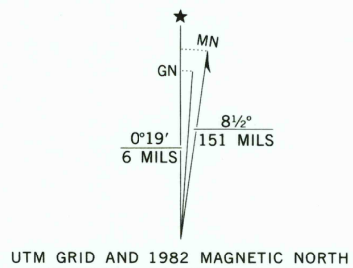

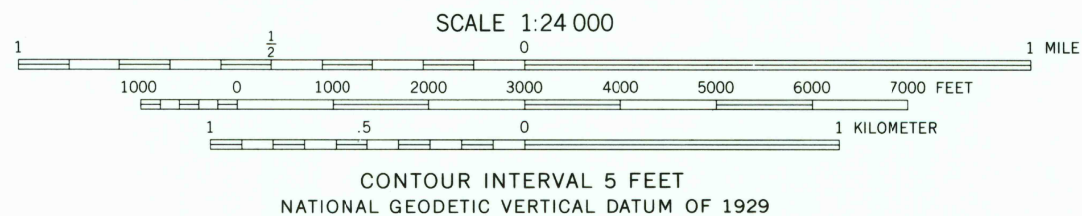
Projection and 10,000-foot grid ticks: North Dakota coordinate system, south zone (Lambert conformal conic)

30 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks

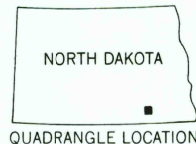
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines
