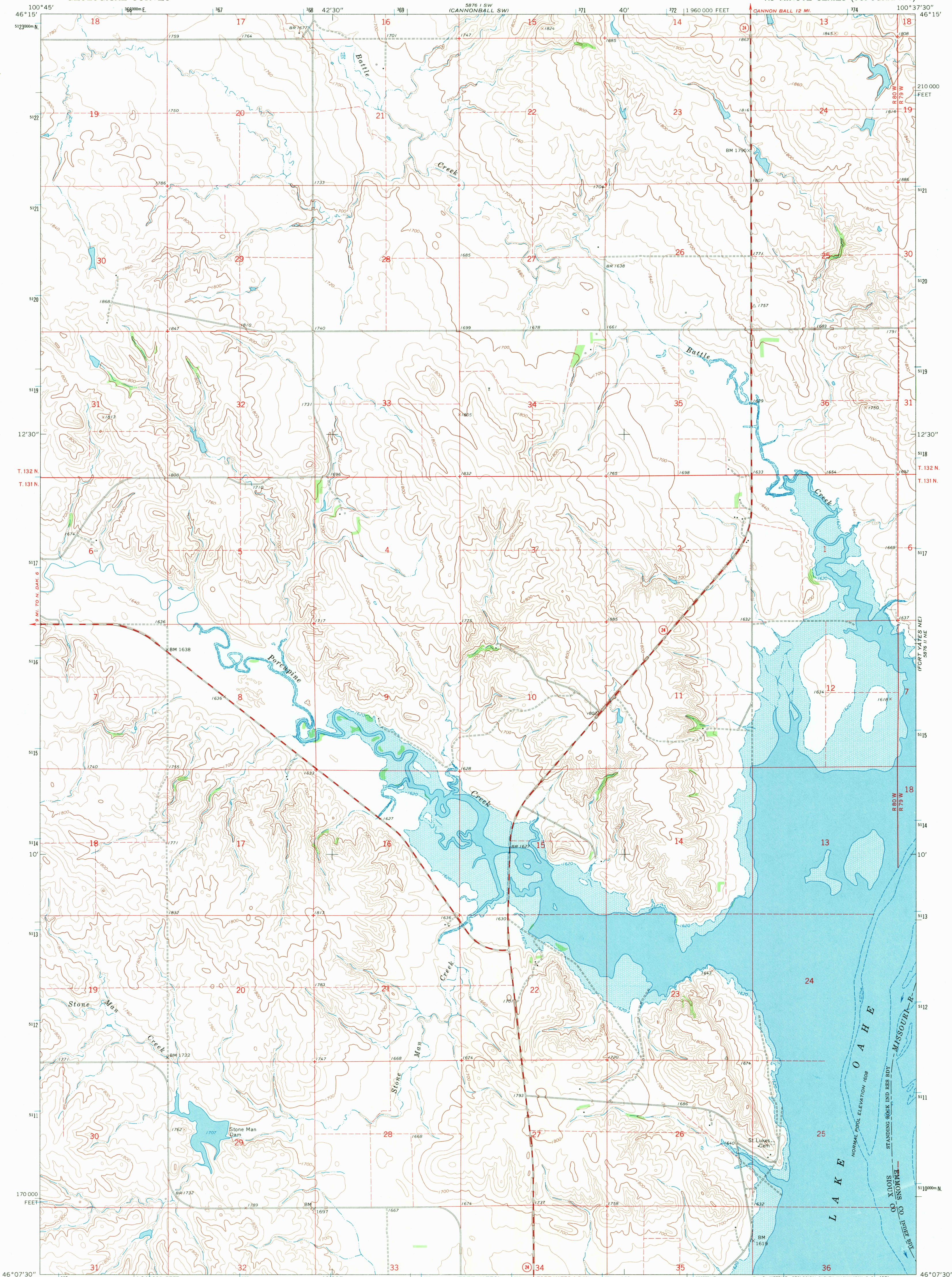
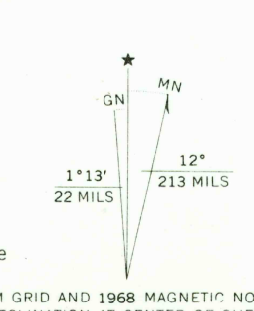

Areas covered by dashed light-blue pattern are subject to controlled inundation. Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs.
