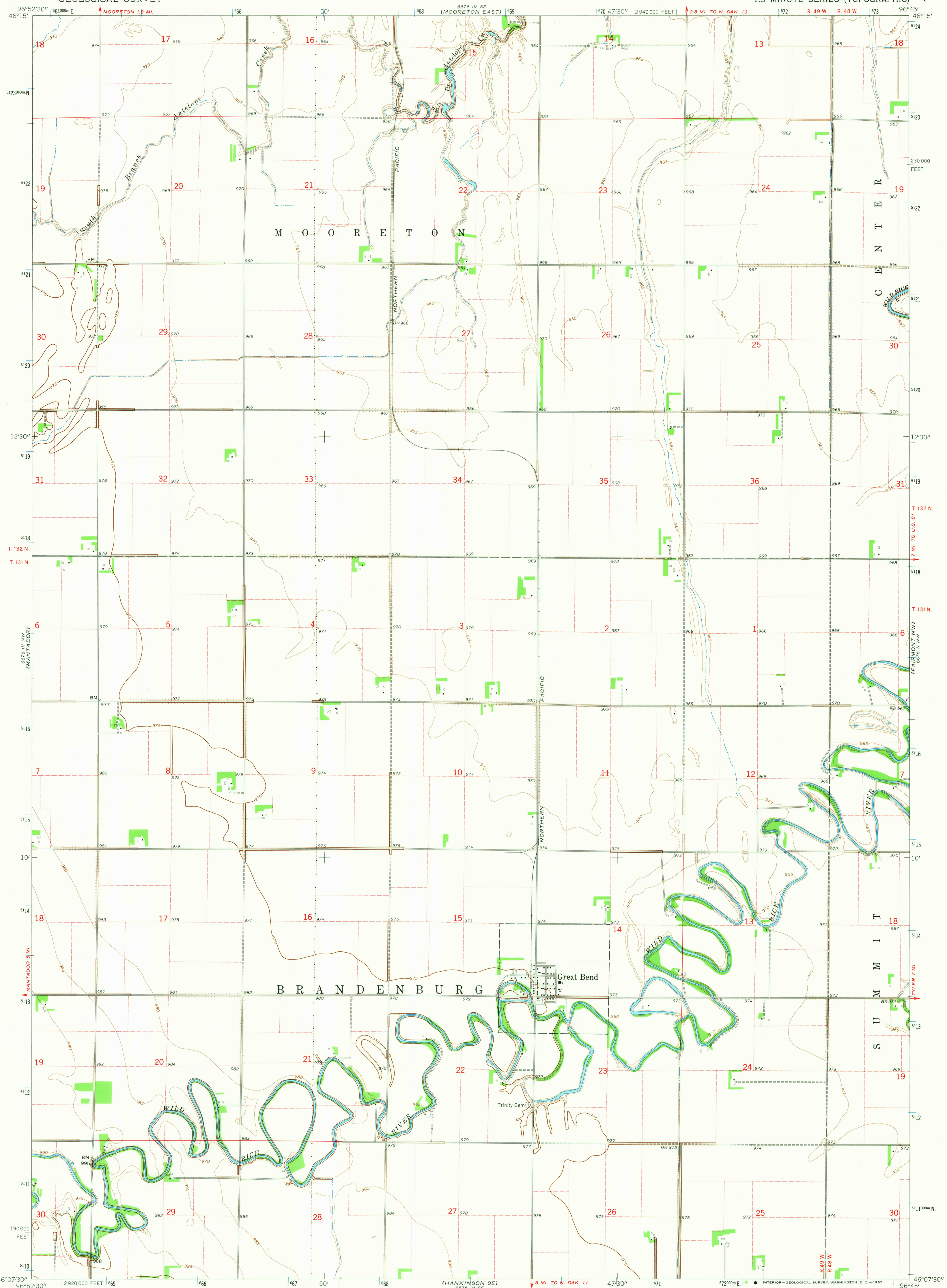

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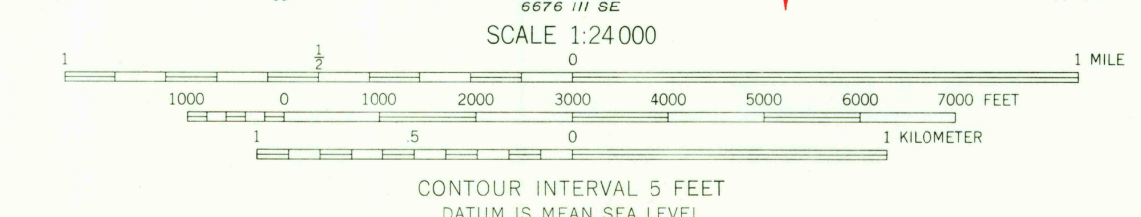

generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked

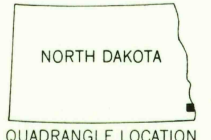


UTM GRID AND 1964 MAGNETIC NORTH
