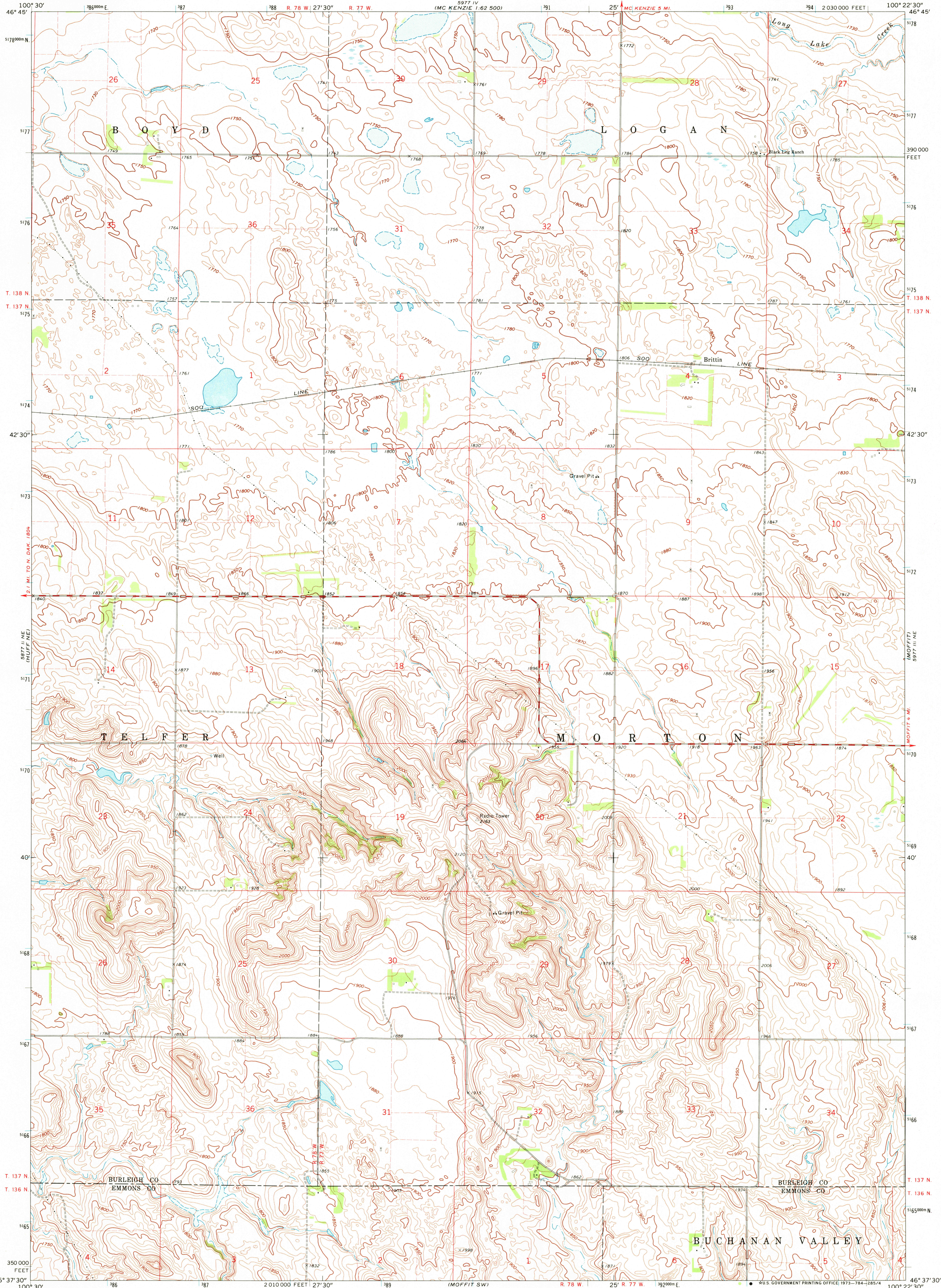
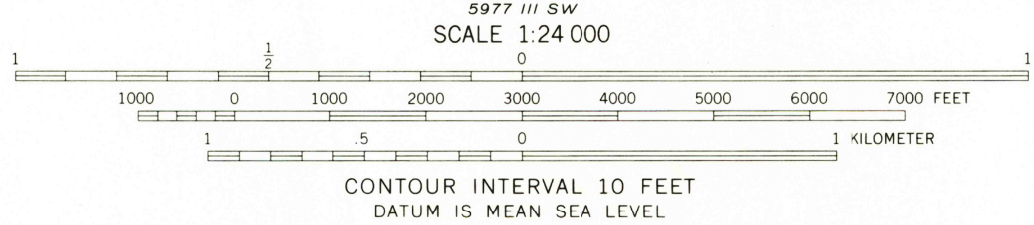

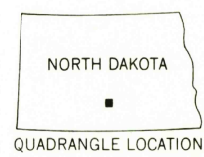
MOFFIT NW QUADRANGLE
