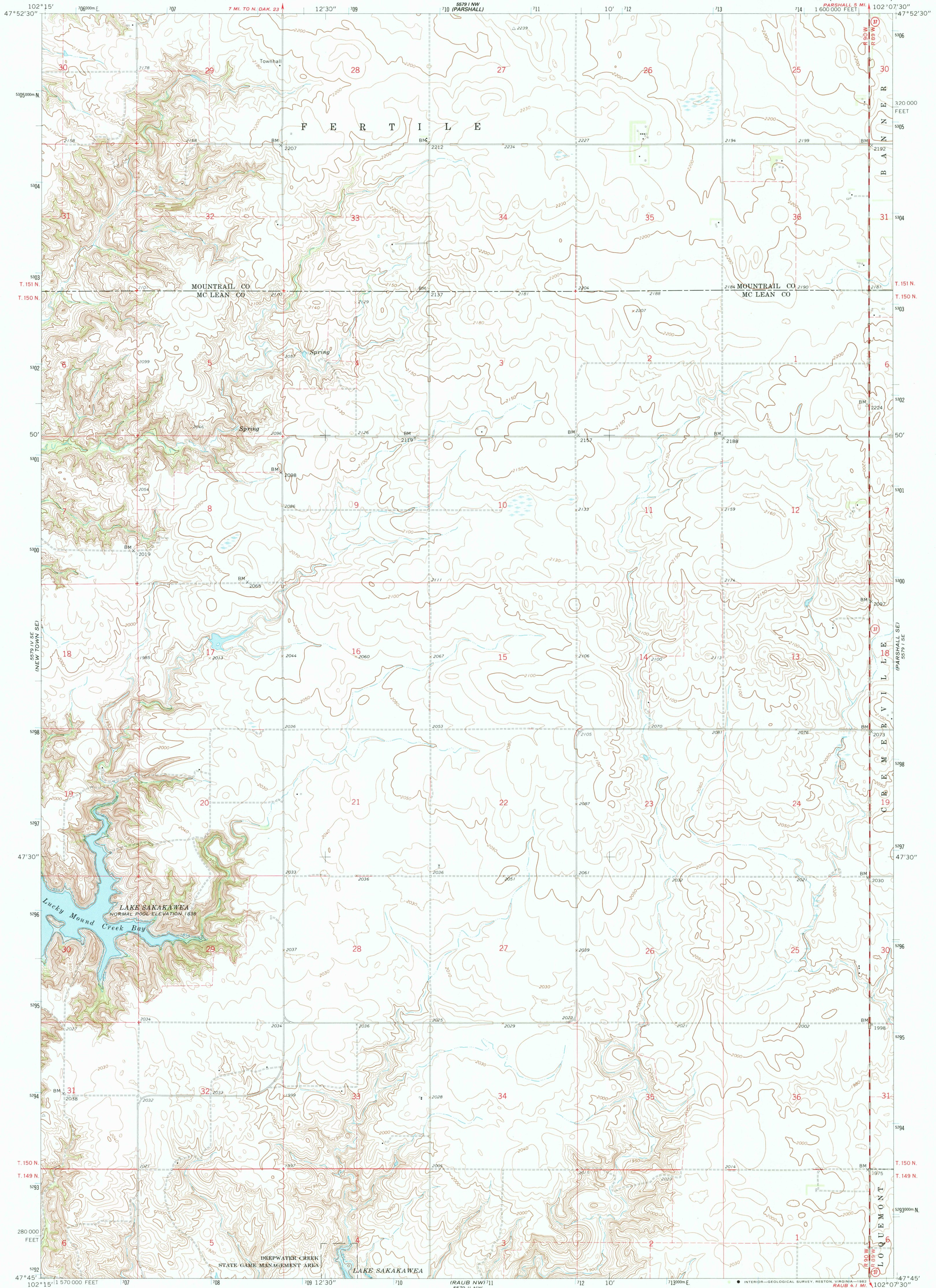

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 4 meters north and 36 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
