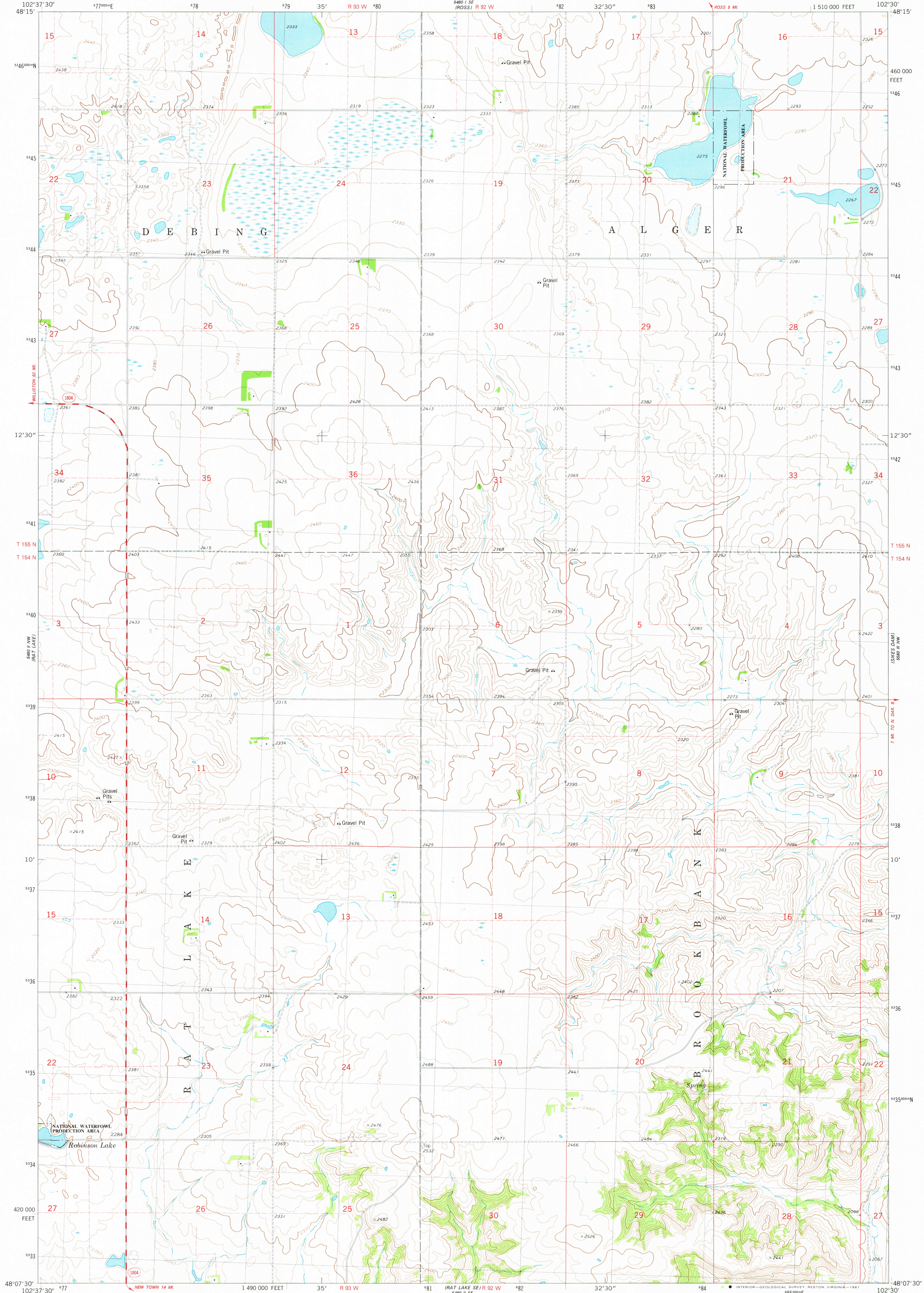

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid, zone 13

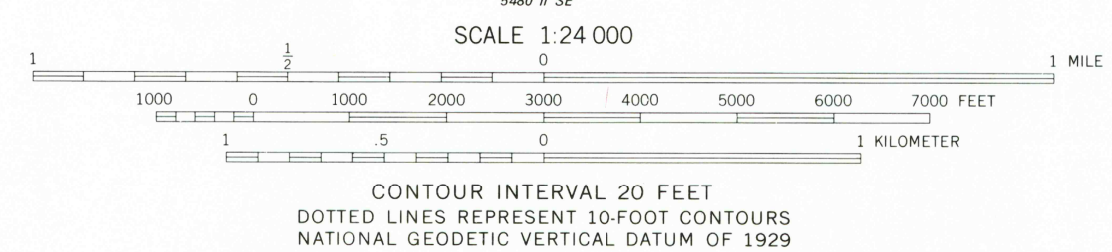
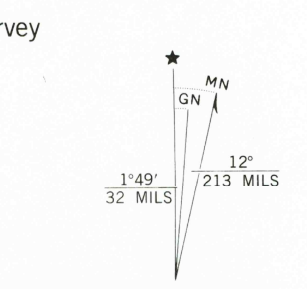
1927 North American Datum
