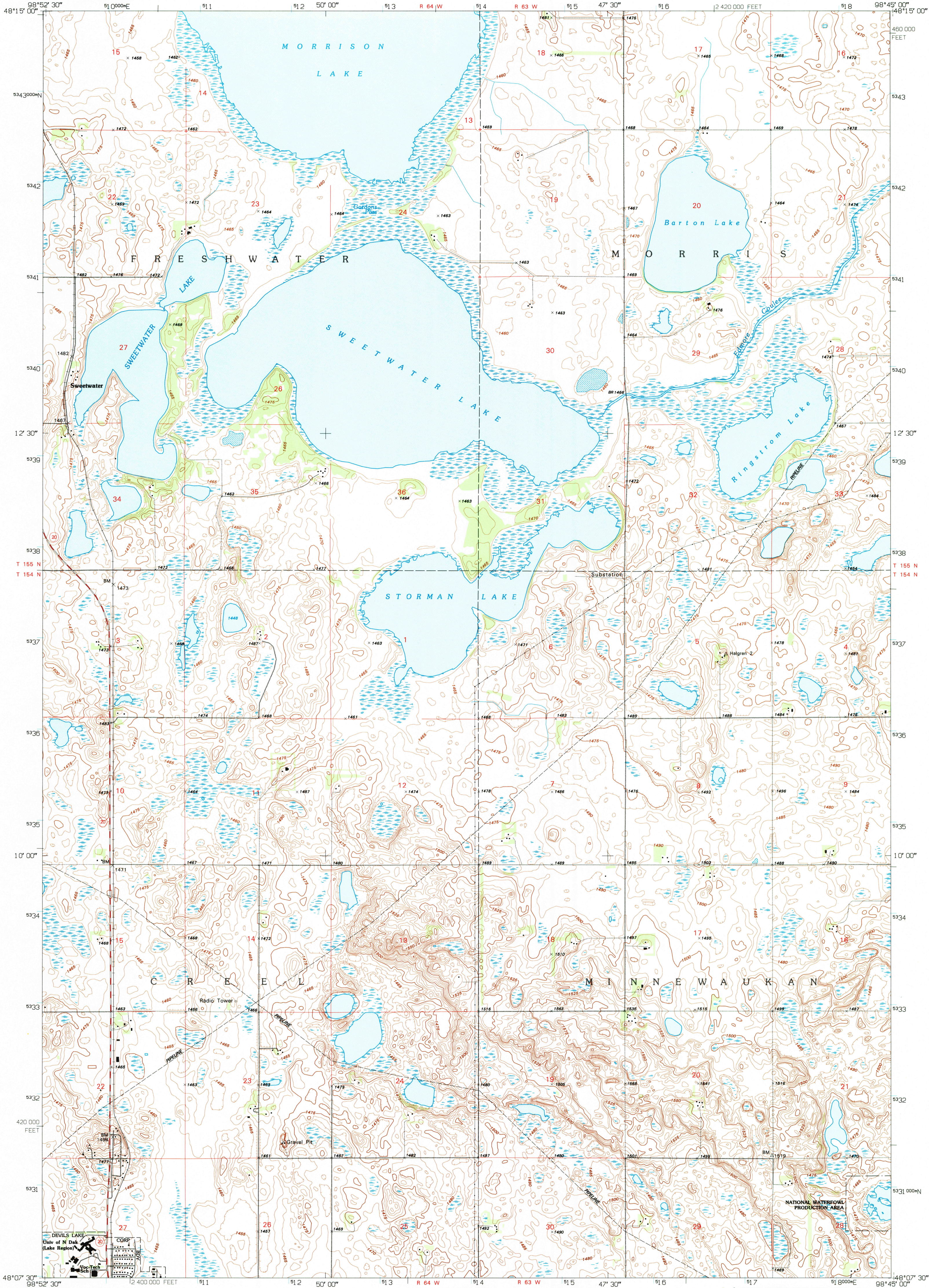

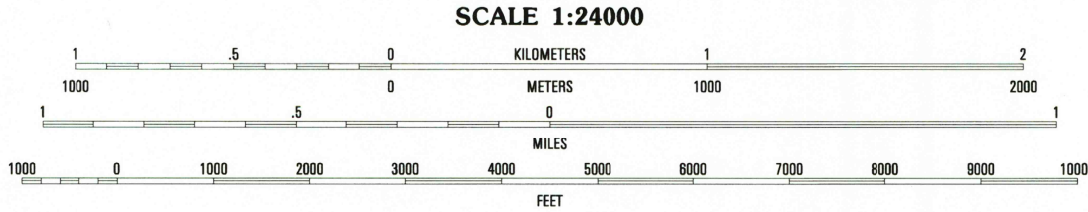

1927 North American Datum (NAD 27)

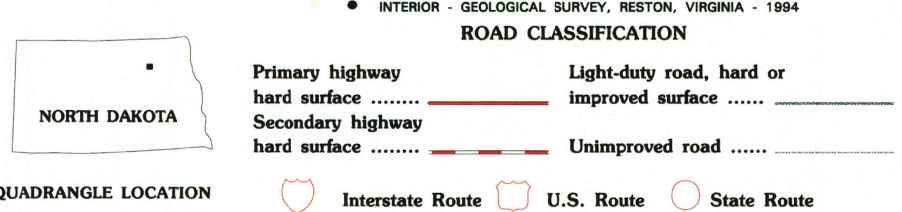
North American Datum of 1983 (NAD 83) is shown by dashed corner ticks.
