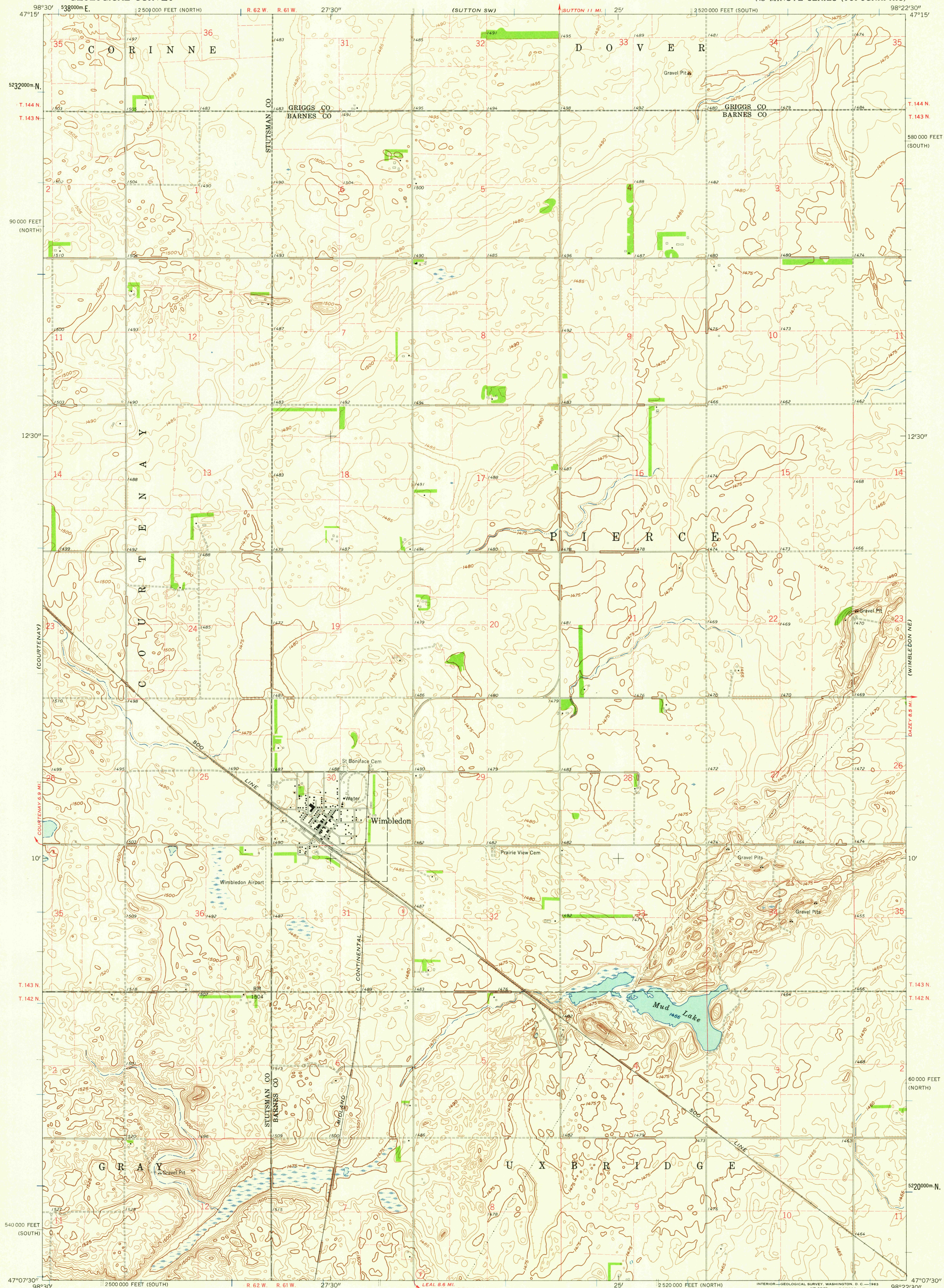

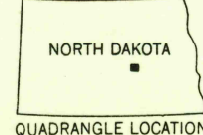
WIMBLEDON QUADRANGLE
