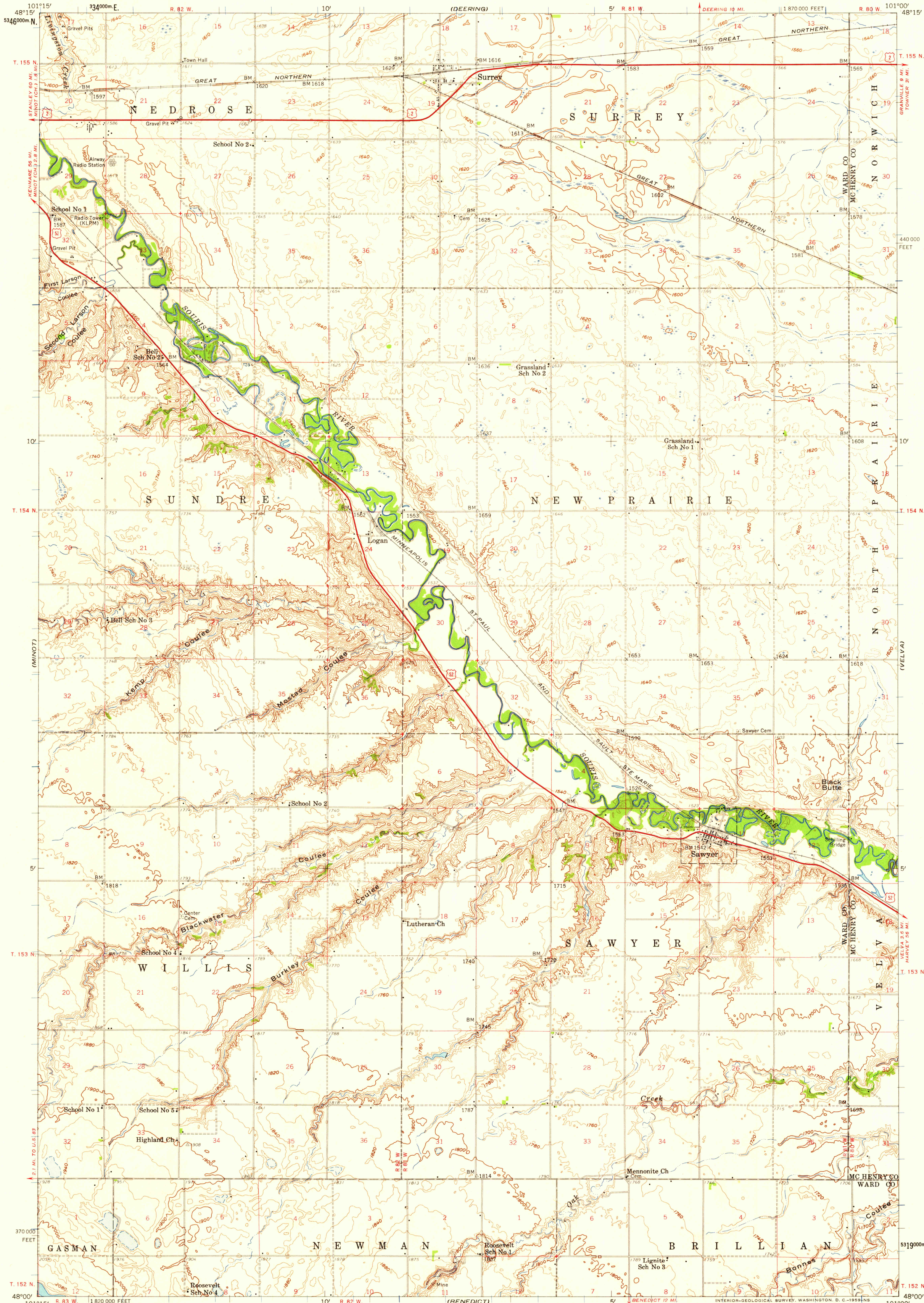

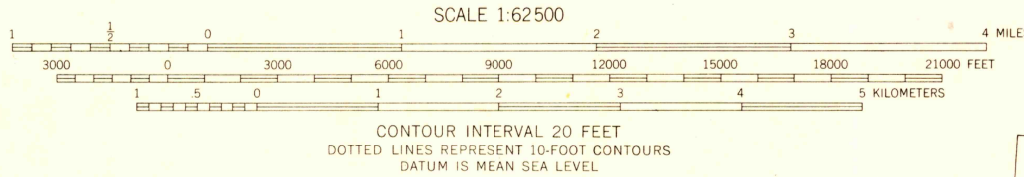
SAWYER QUADRANGLE

15 MINUTE SERIES (TOPOGRAPHIC)



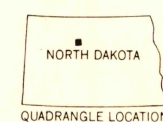
