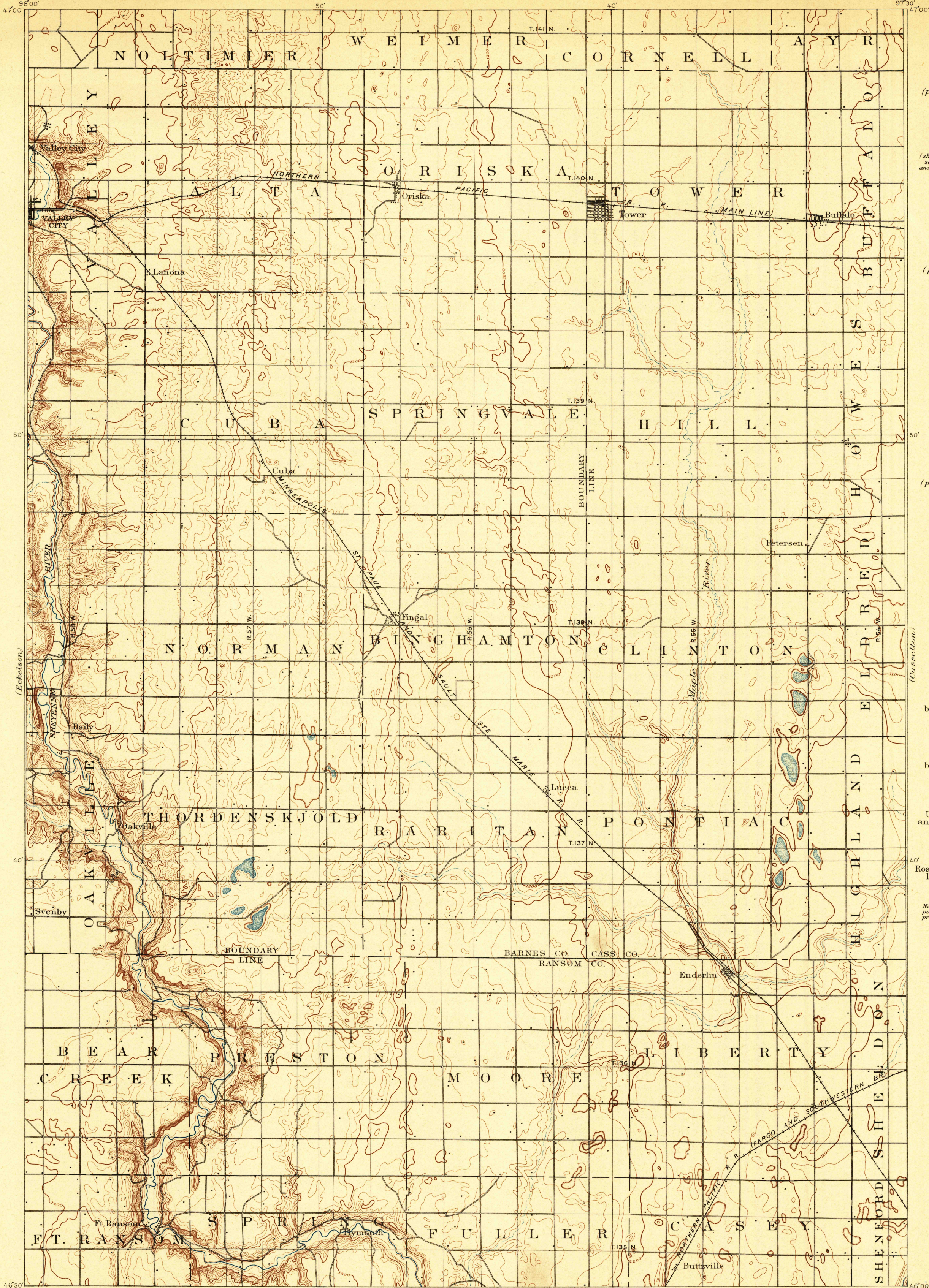

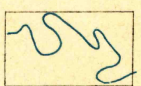

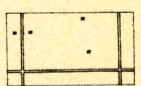

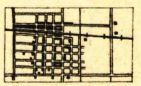

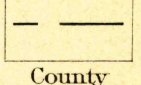

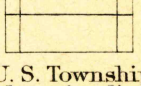

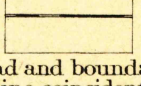

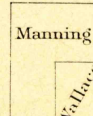
U.S. Township and section lines
