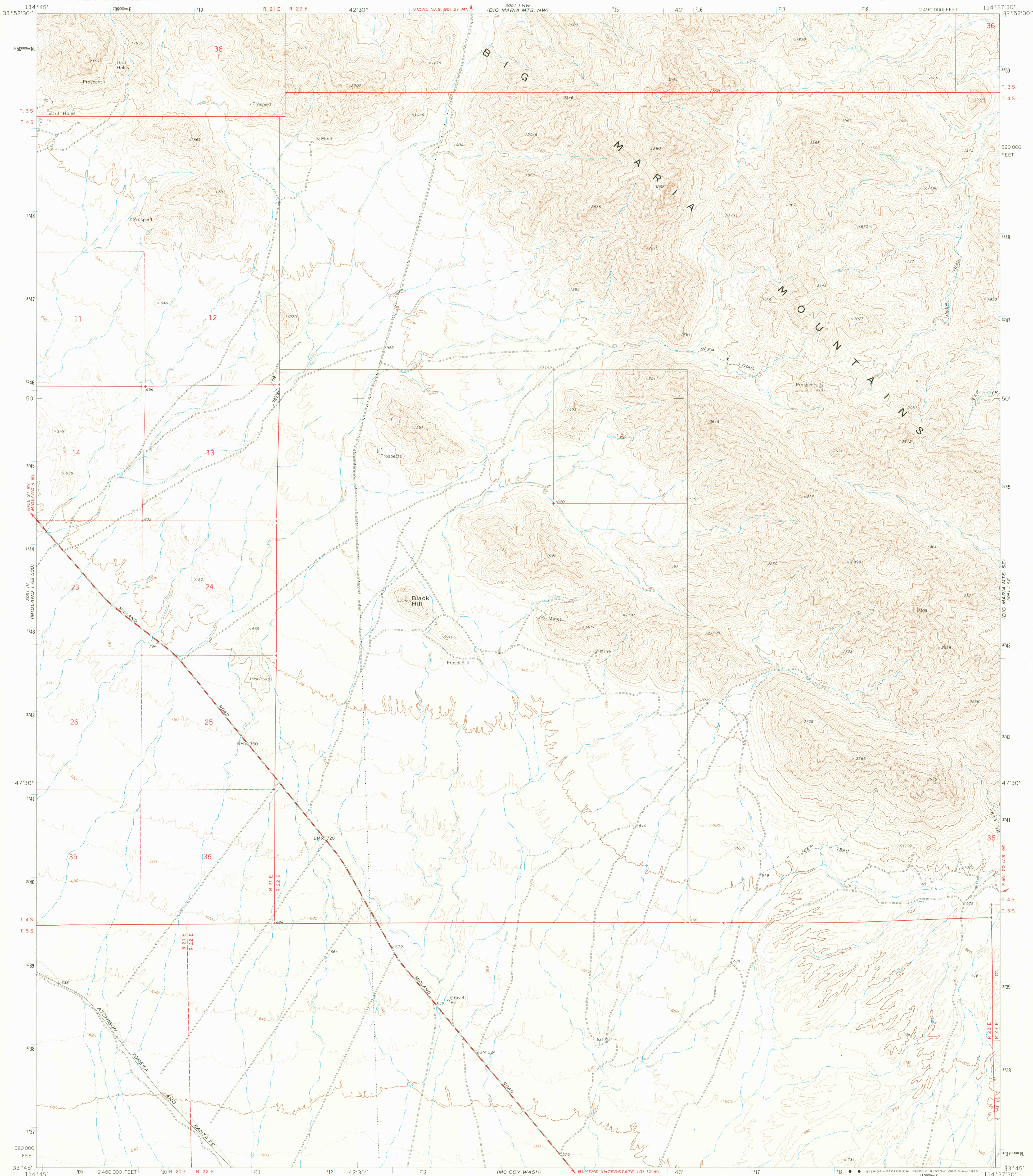

move the projection lines 1 meter south and

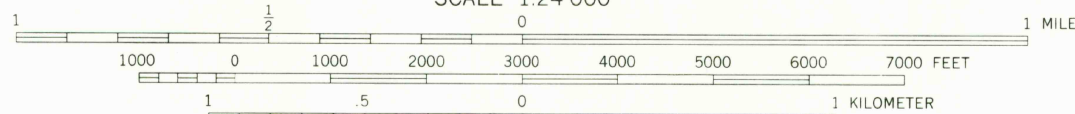
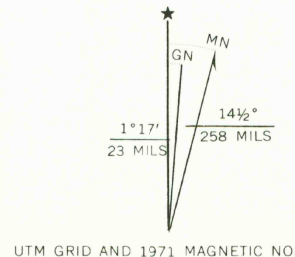
73 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
