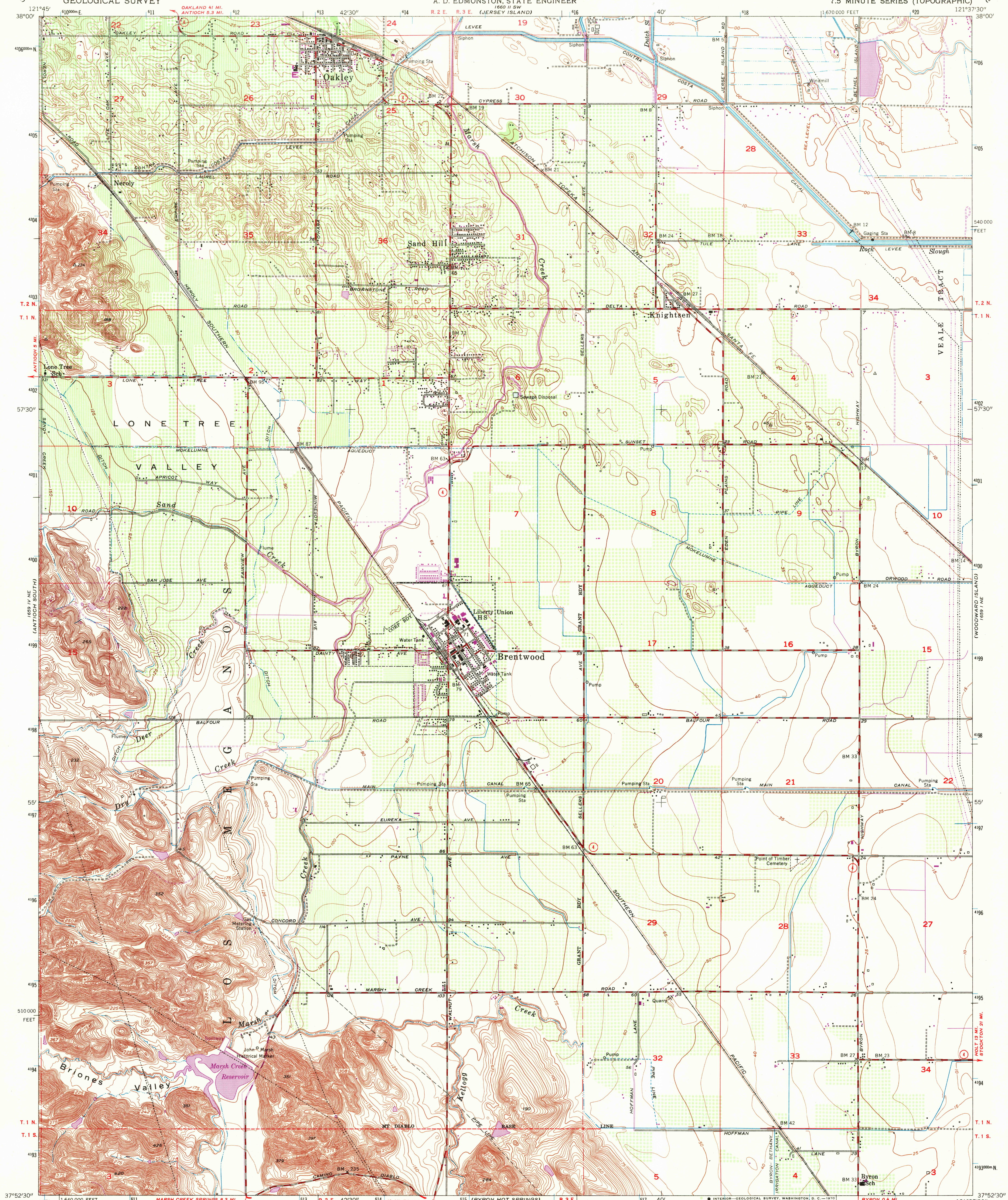

10,000-foot grid based on California coordinate system, zone 3

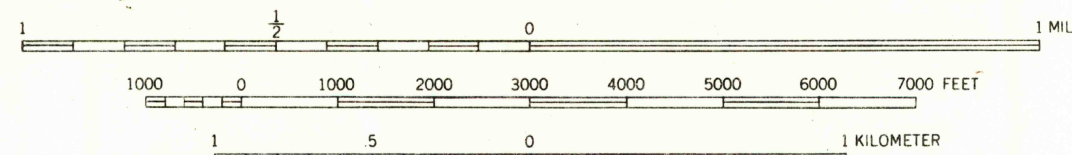
Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations
