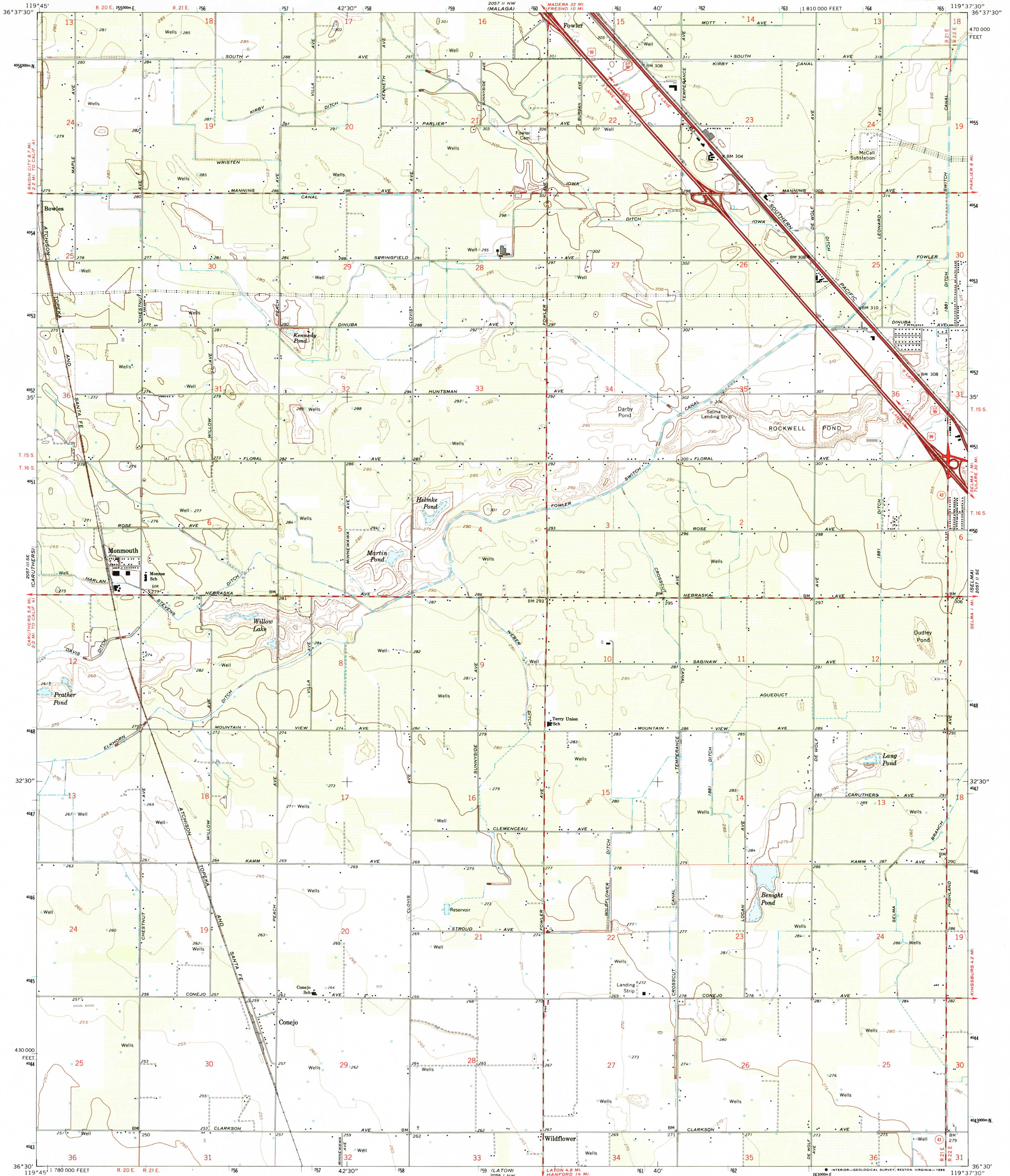

Planimetry by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1962. Topography by planimetric surveys 1963

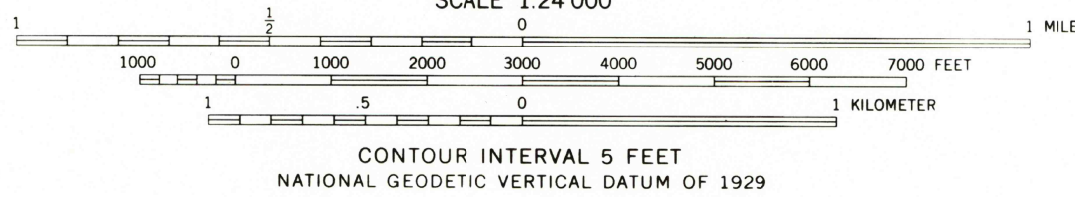
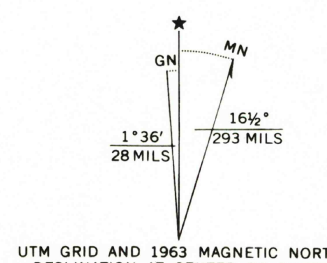
Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum 10,000-foot grid based on California coordinate system, zone 4 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 11, shown in blue

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 8 meters north and 87 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines

A portion of the northwest quarter lies within a subsidence area

Vertical control based on latest available adjustment
