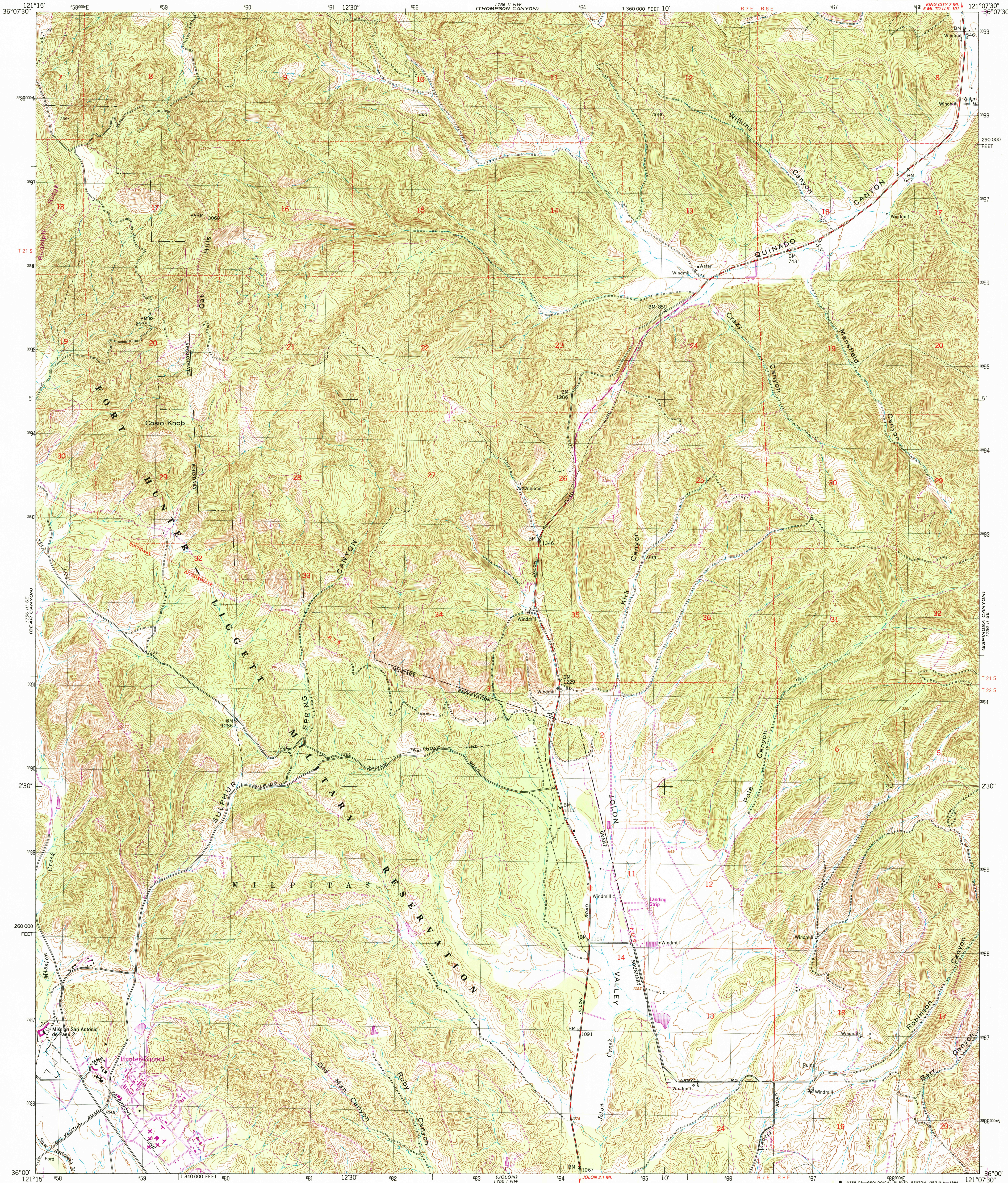

Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations

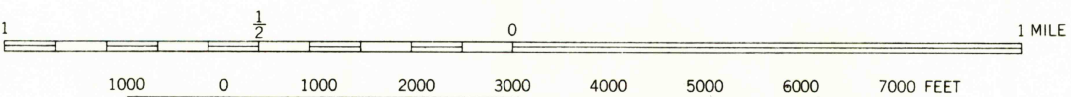
1000 meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,

91 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks

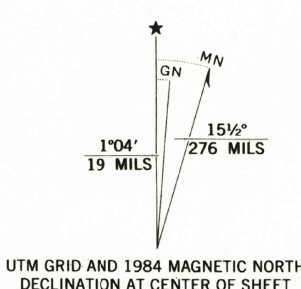
