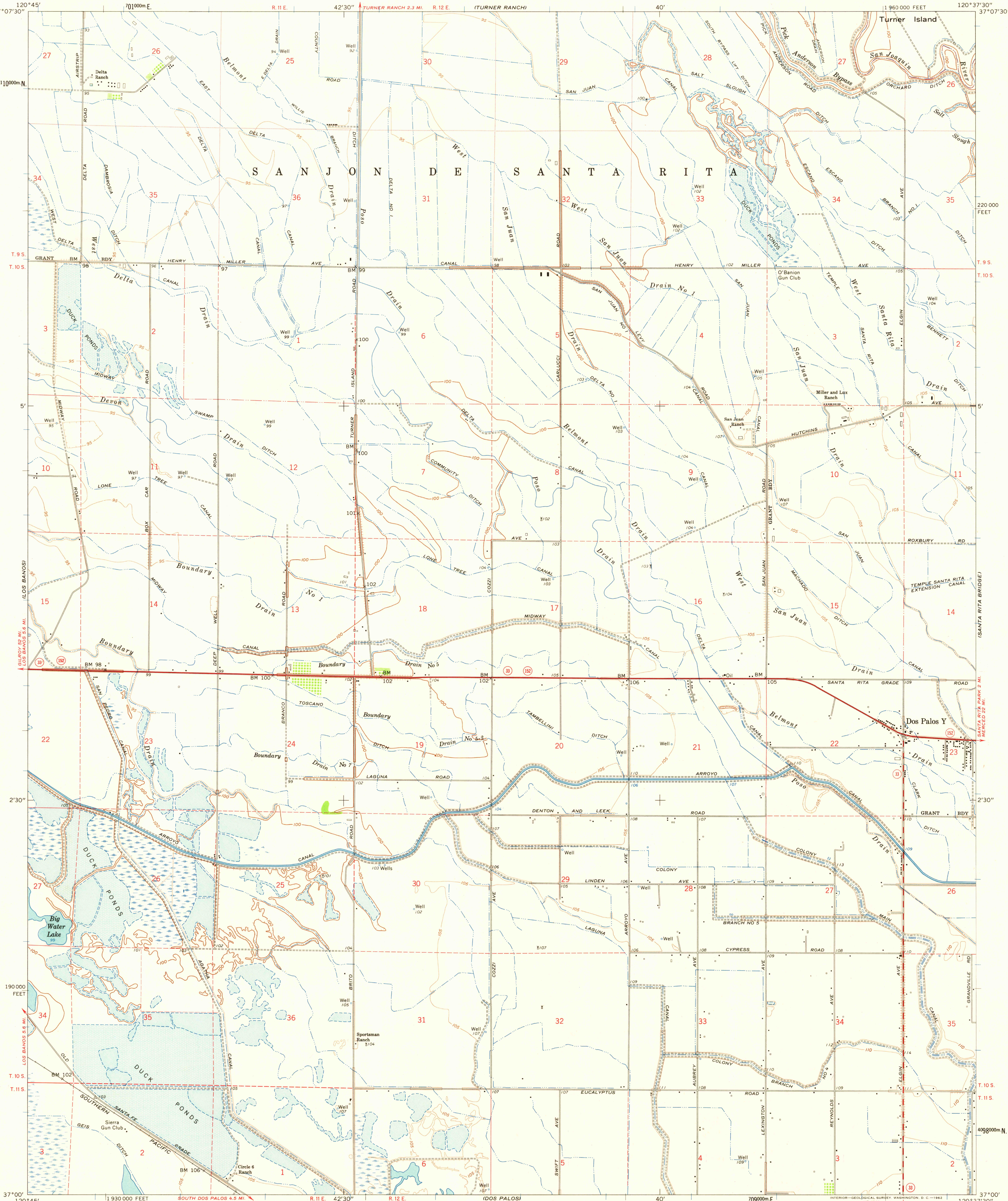

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 10, shown in blue

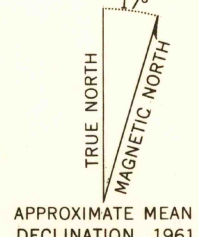
Dotted land lines established by private survey

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines

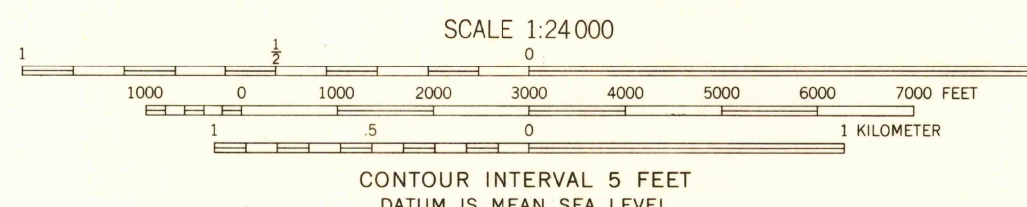
