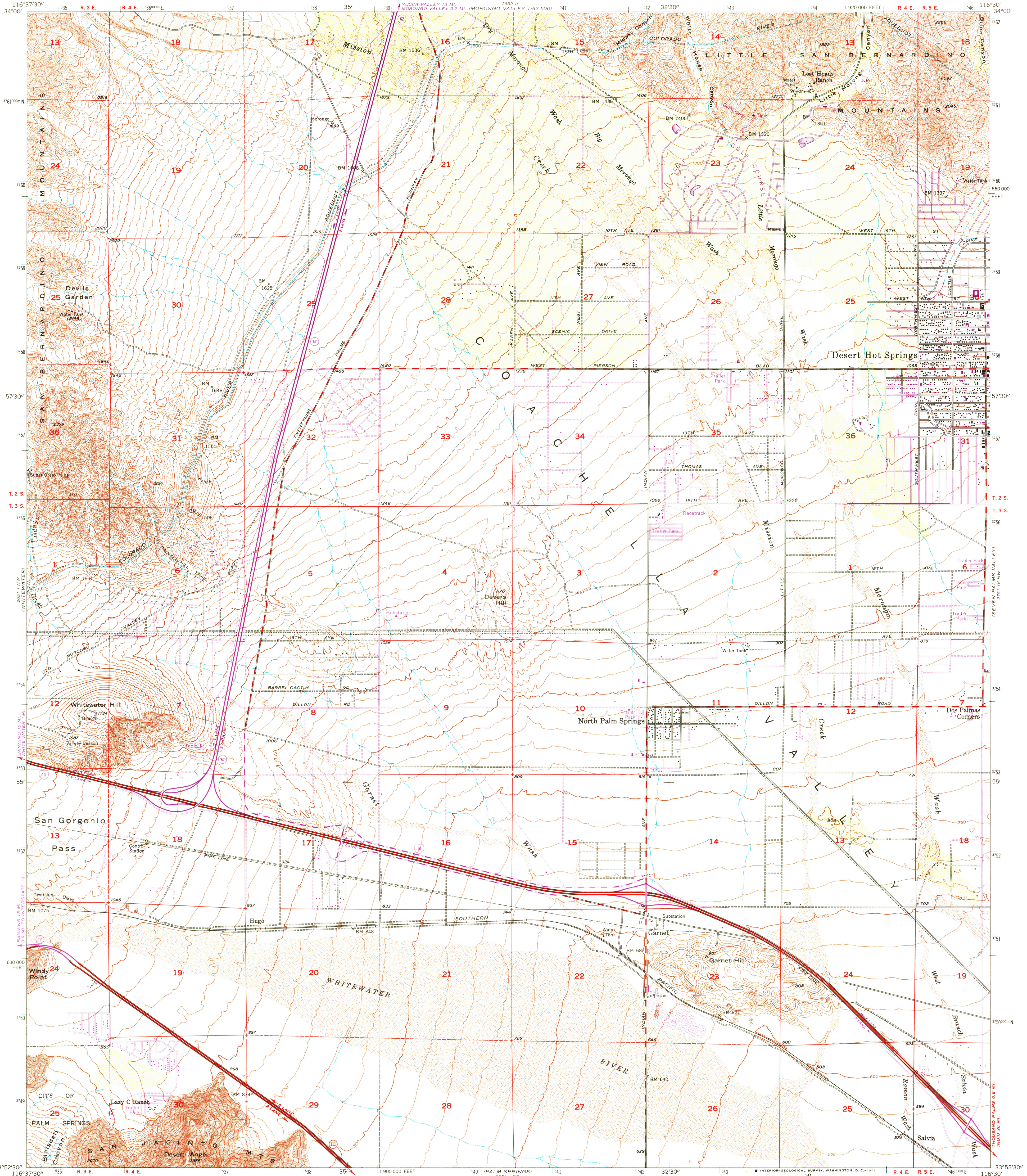

10,000-foot grid based on California coordinate system, zone 6

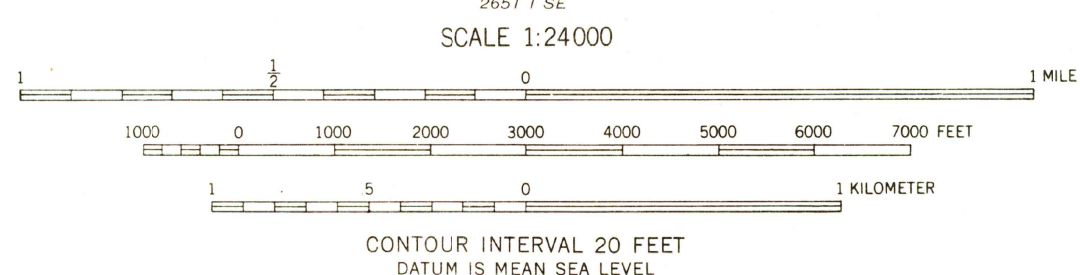
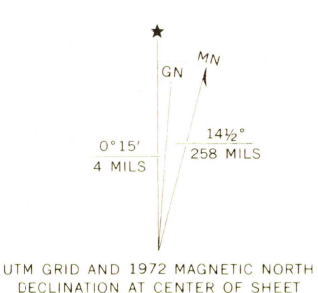
Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,

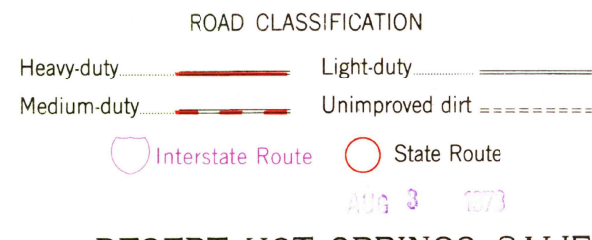
zone 11, shown in blue
