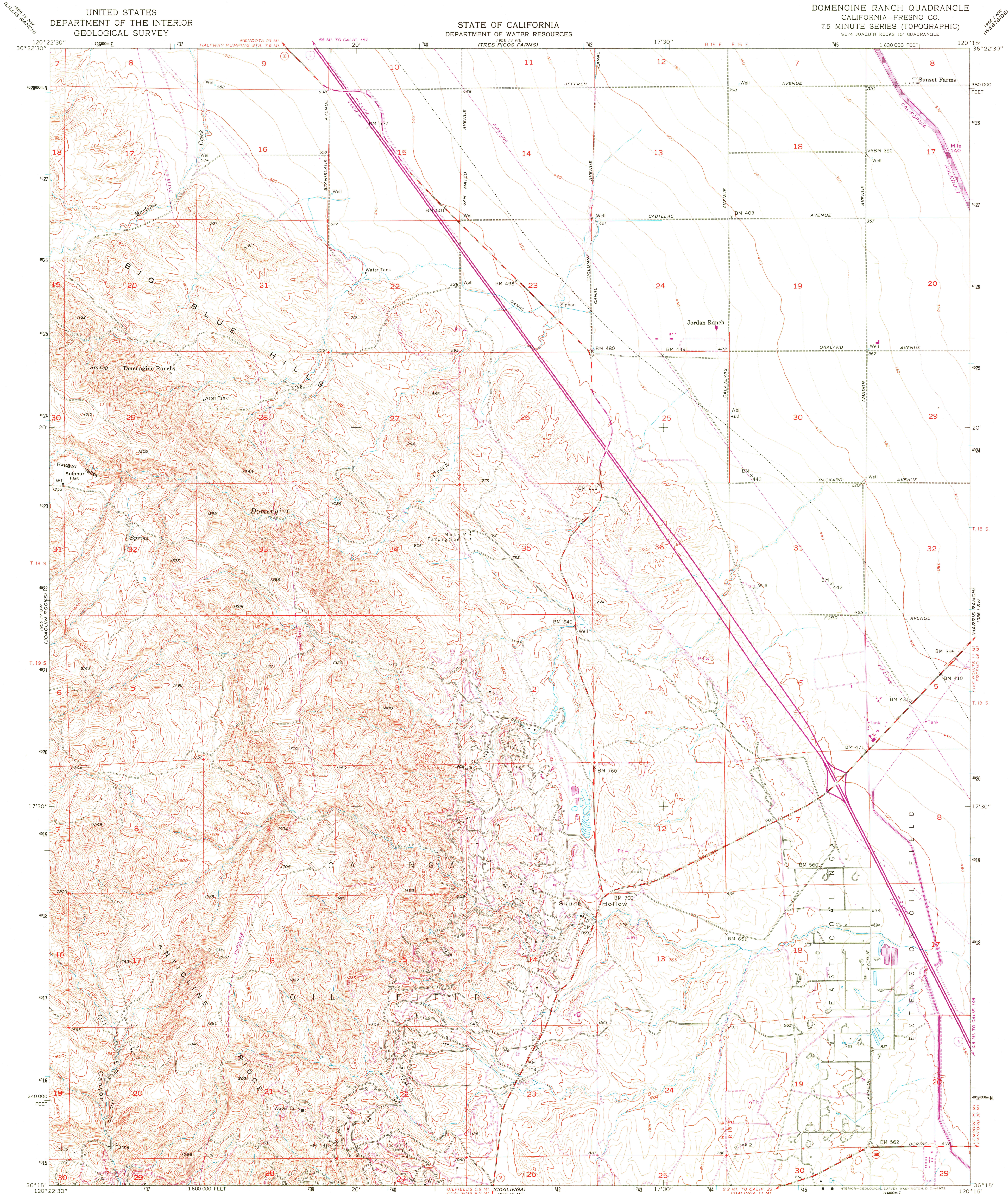

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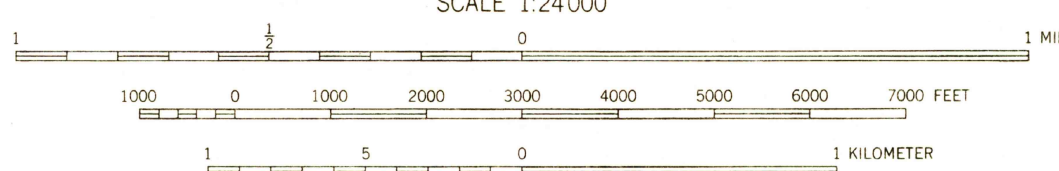
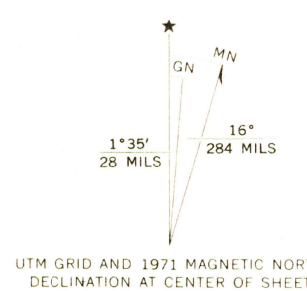
Topography from aerial photographs by multiplex methods and by planetable surveys 1956. Aerial photographs taken 1953

Revisions shown in purple compiled from aerial photographs taken 1971. This information not field checked

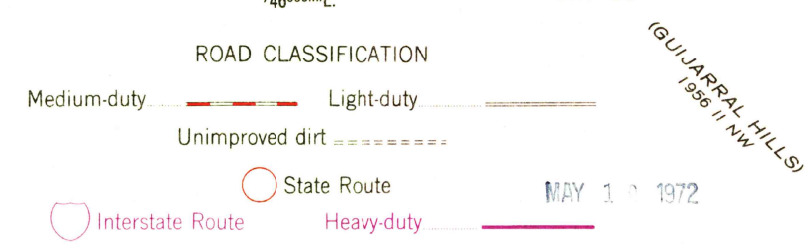
