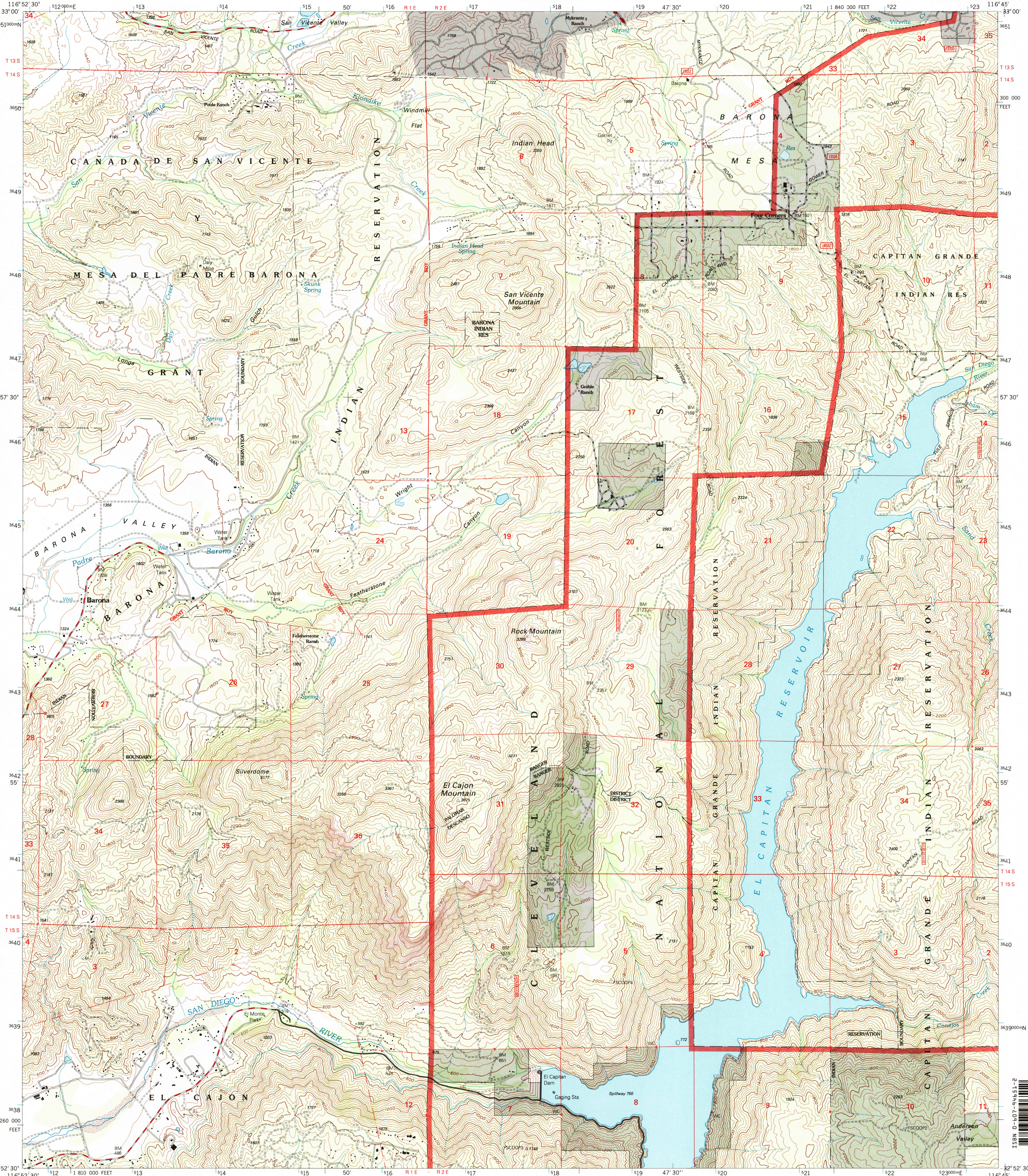

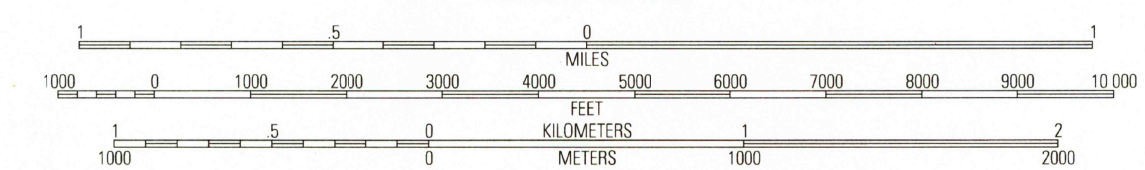
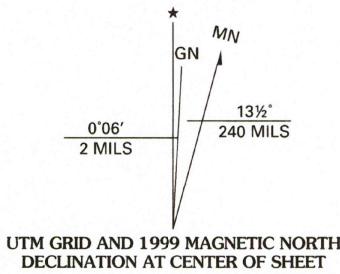
Topography compiled 1949. Planimetry derived from imagery taken 1994 and other sources. Public Land Survey System and survey control current as of 1997.
