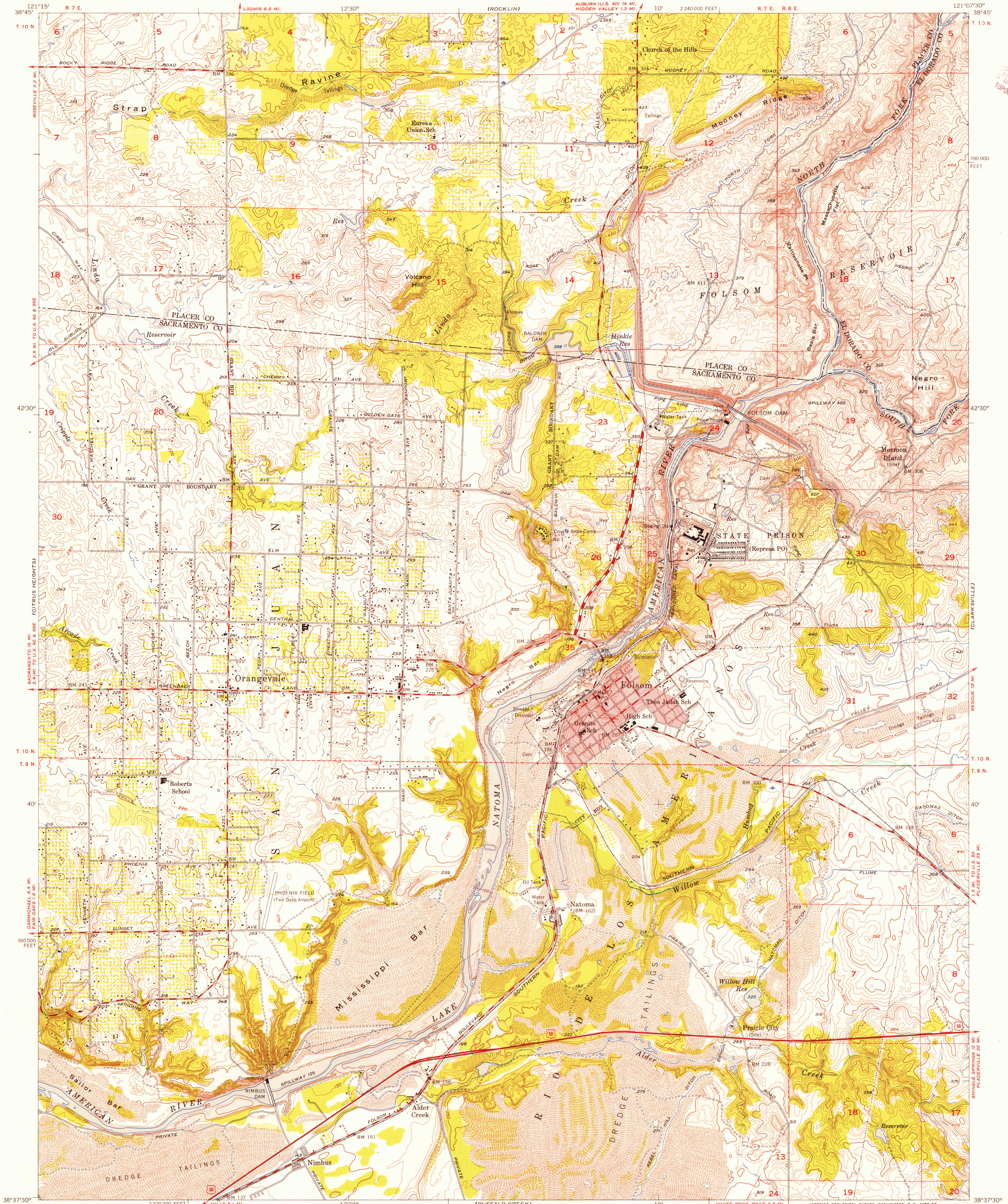

10,000-foot grid based on California coordinate system, zone 2

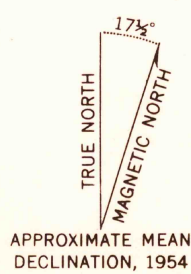
Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown

Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations

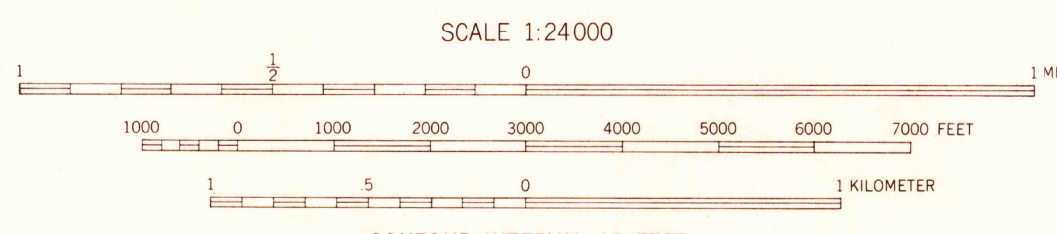
Land grant boundaries which follow the banks of the American River are not shown
