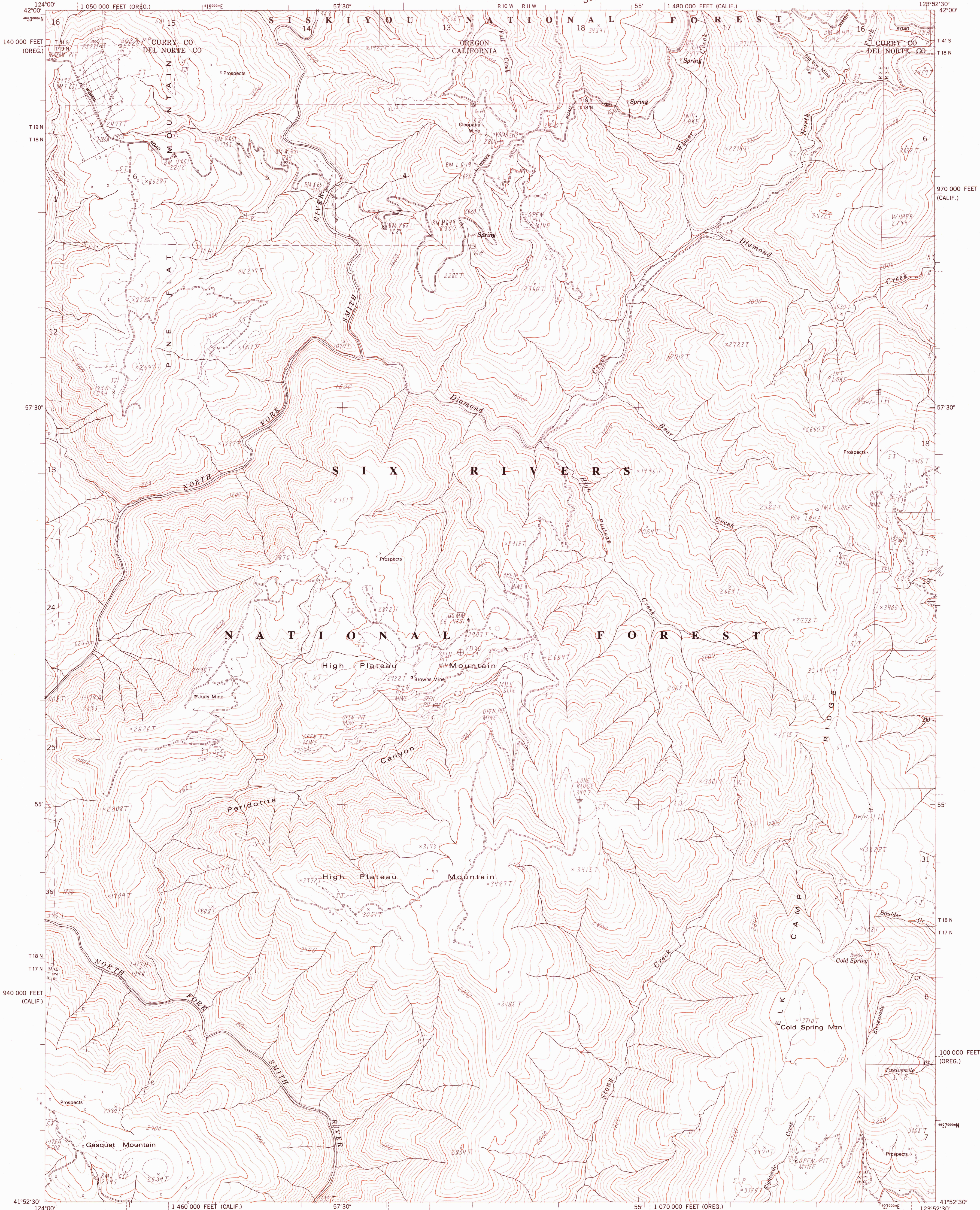


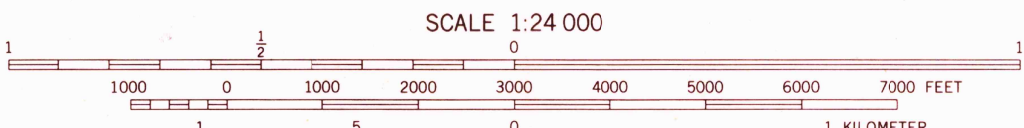

MONUMENT FOUND
1 Iron pipe (GLO) cap
2 Iron pipe, other official cap
3 Private L.S. pipe & cap or comparable mon.
4 Notched rock
5 Wood post, scrubbed
6 Bearing tree, authentic, BLM notes used
7 Fence corner
8 Centerline x road or road or road & fence
9 Wood stake, charred or defaced
10 Iron pipe not marked
11 Carved stone mound of rock
Marks 1 through 6 carry the square symbol
Marks 7 through 11 carry the circle symbol when verified
