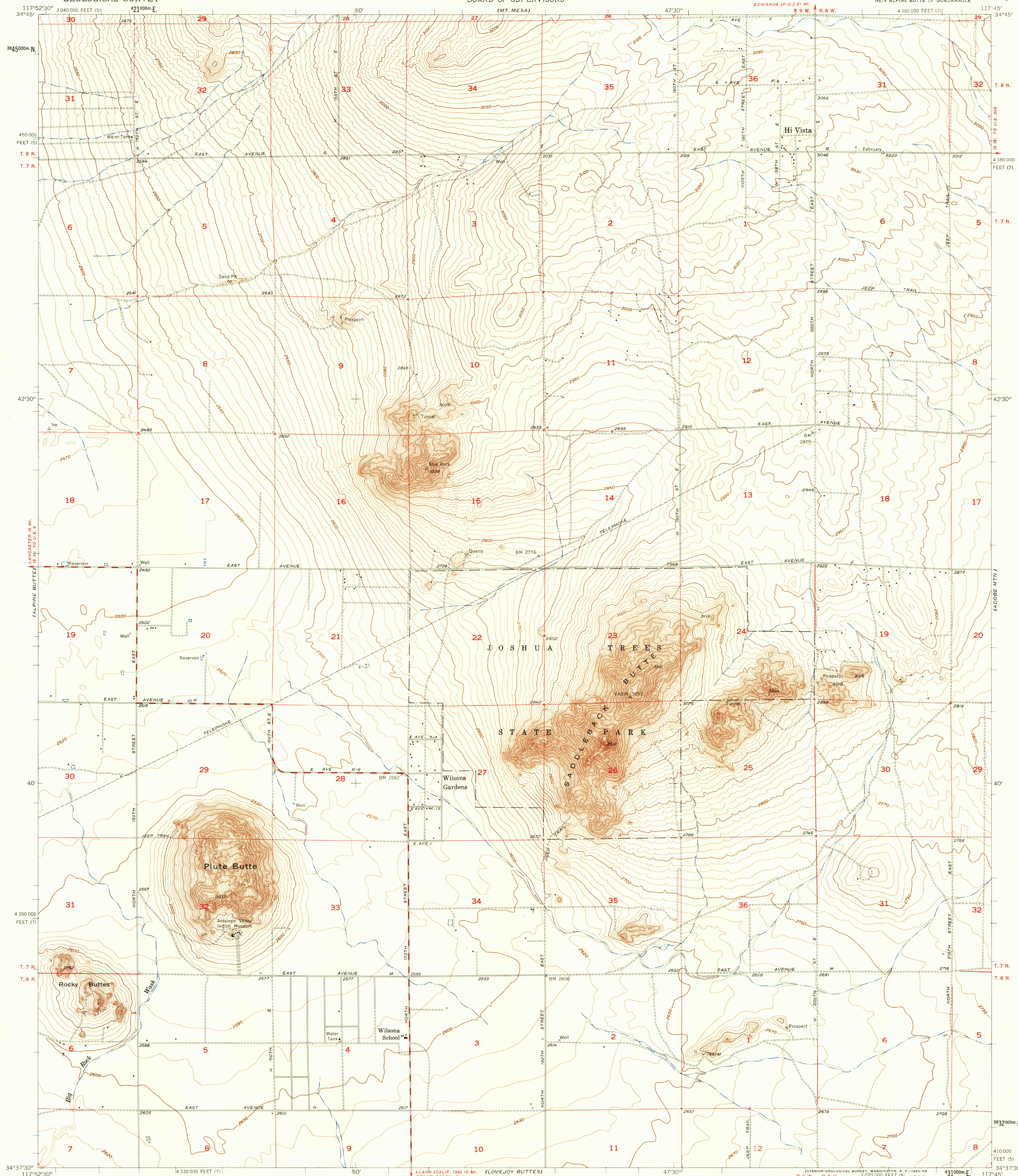

NE 1/4 ALPINE BUTTE 15' QUADRANGLE

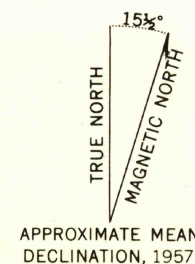

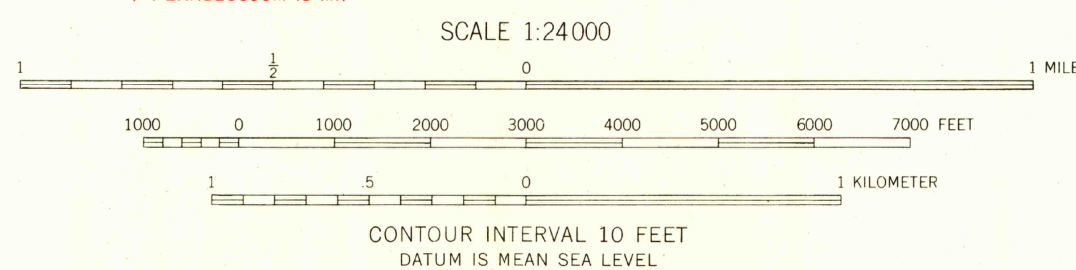
