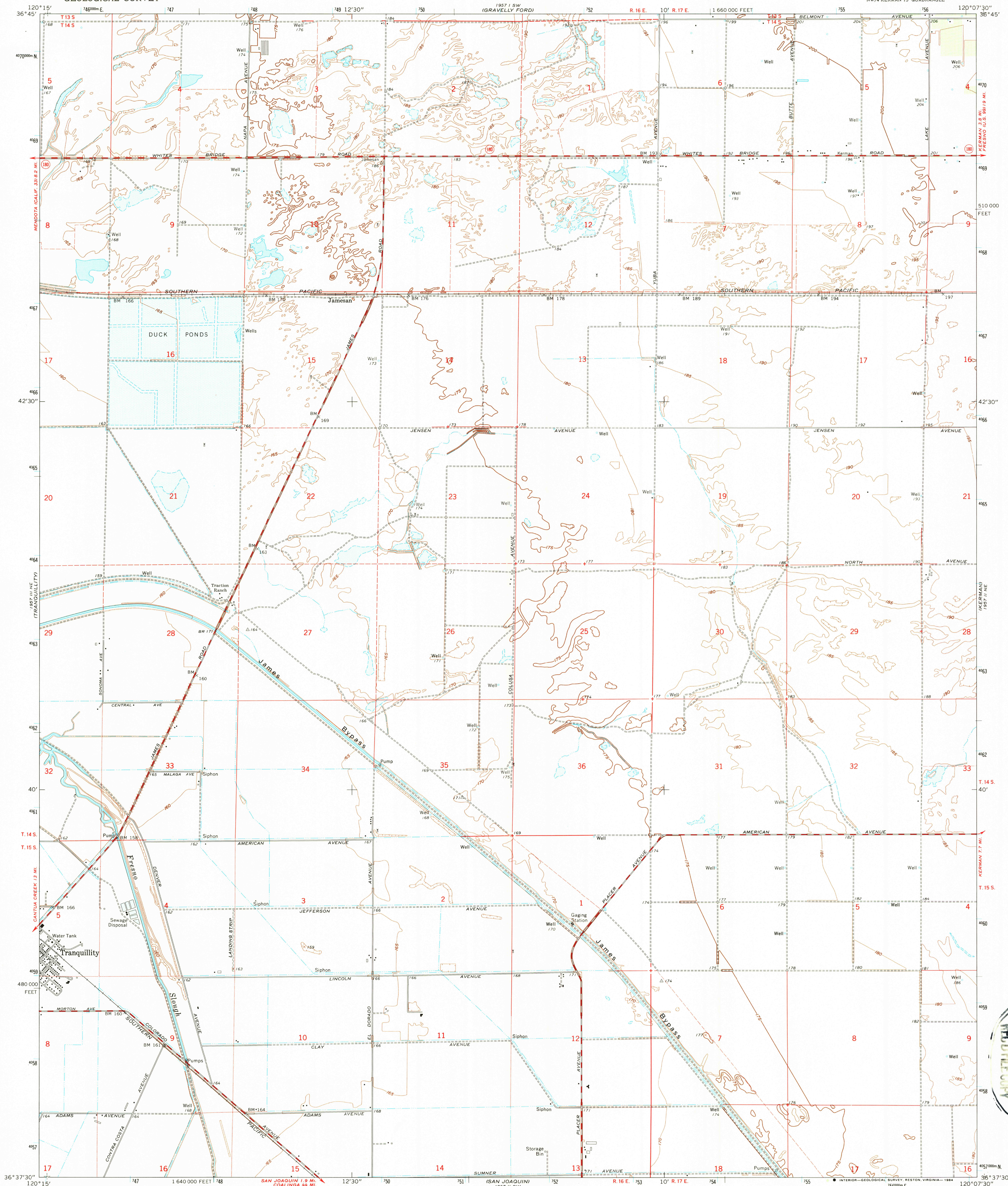

91 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks

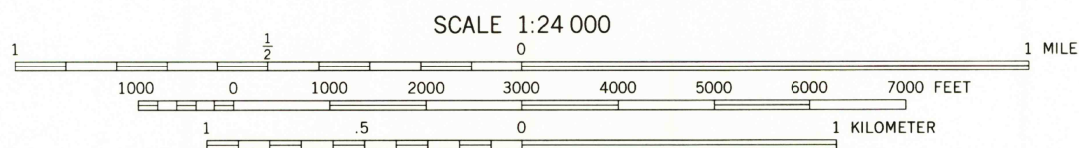
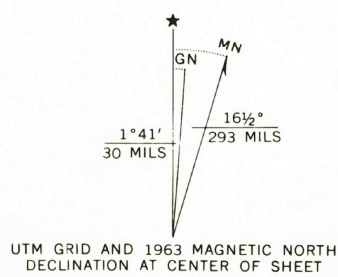
Dotted land lines established by private survey
