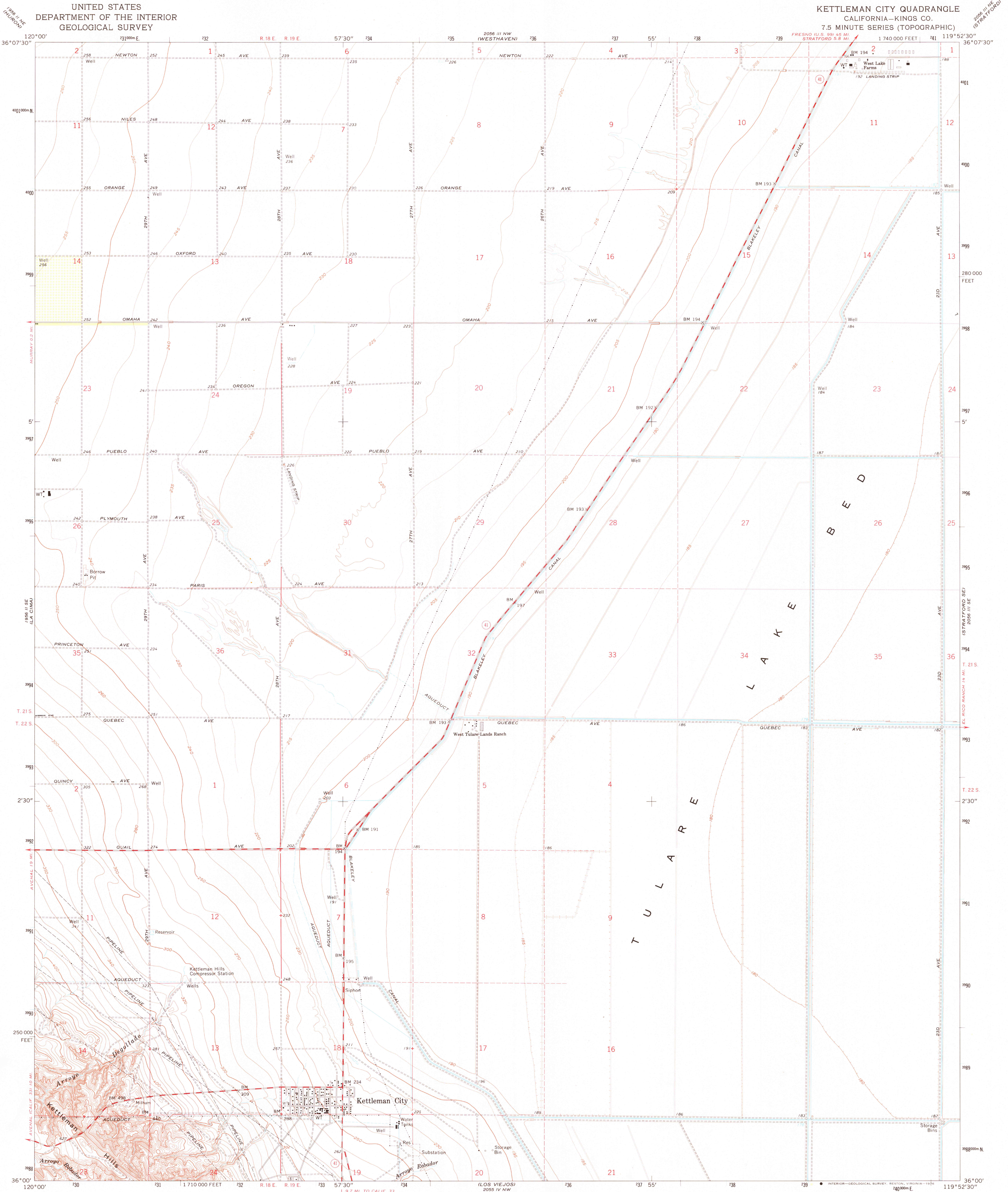

1000-metre Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,

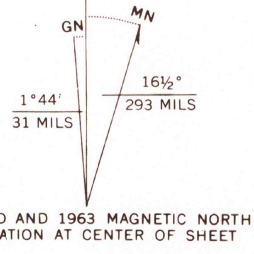
zone 11, shown in blue
