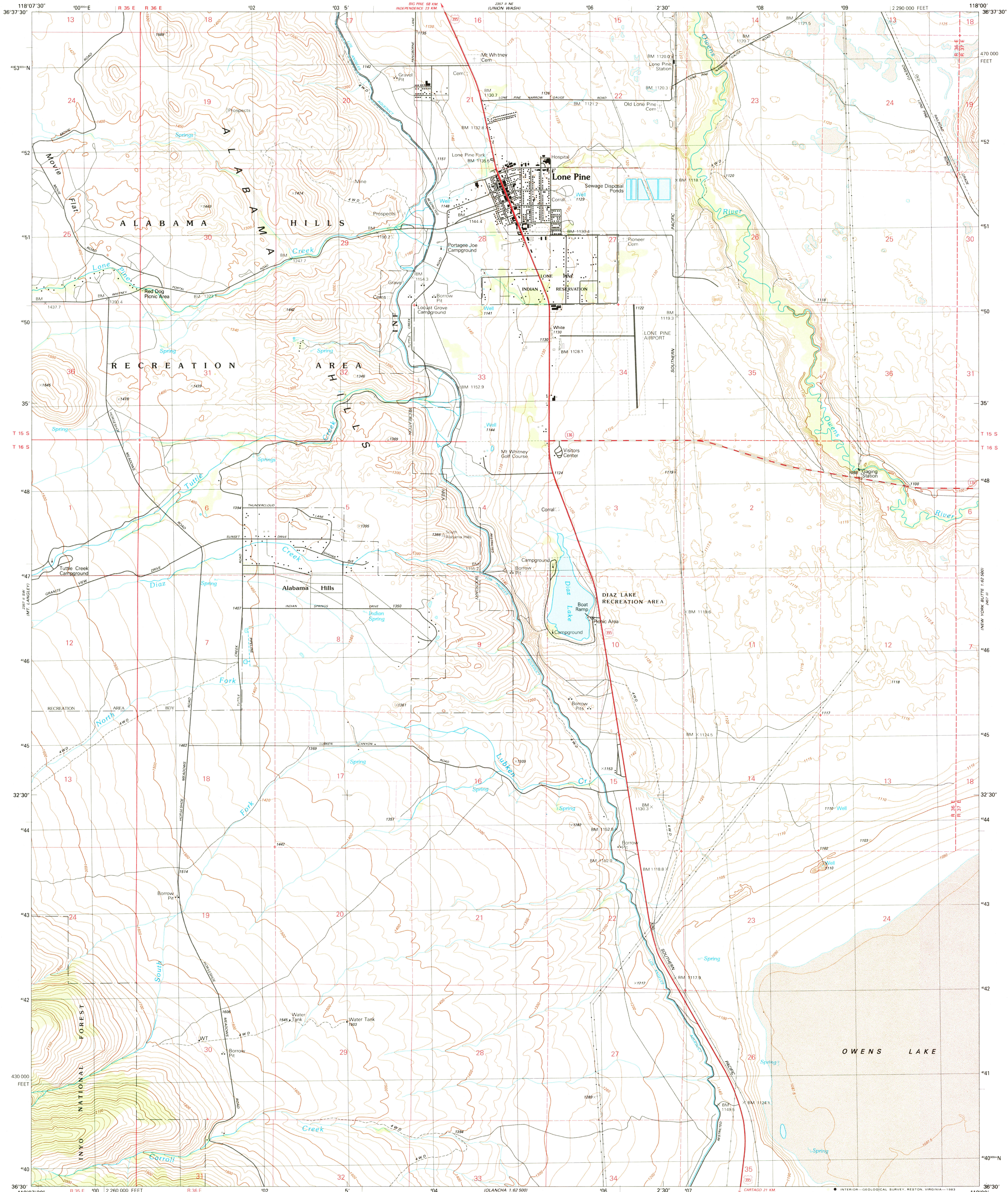

10,000-foot grid ticks based on California coordinate system, zone 4, 1927 North American Datum

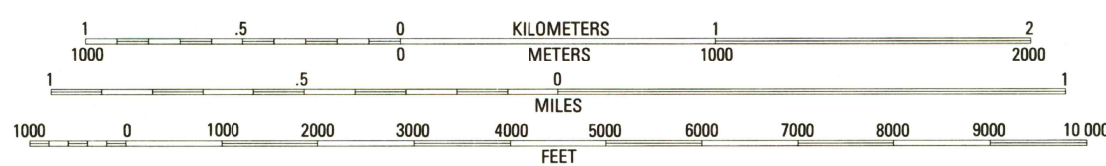
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 8 meters north and 83 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
