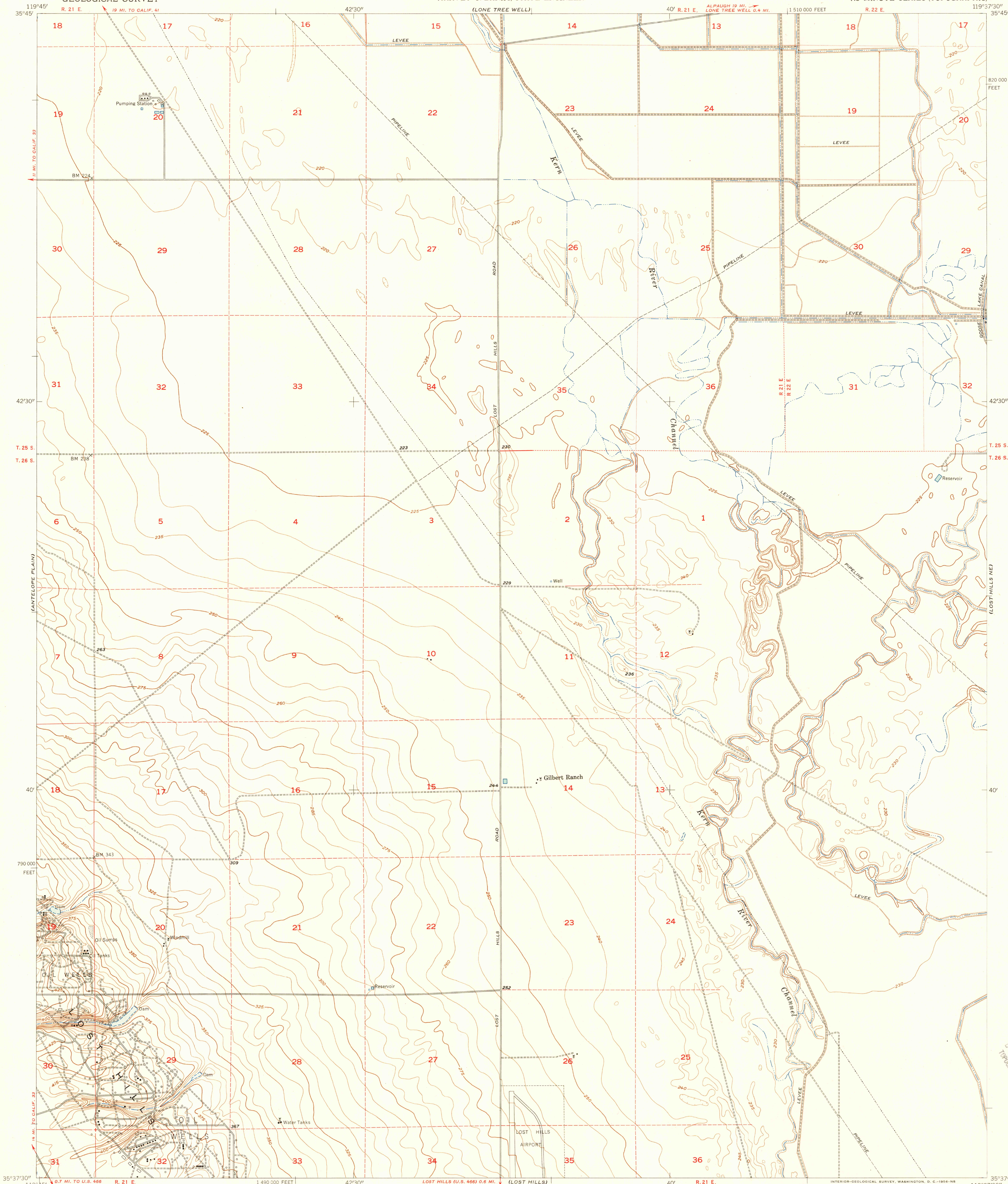

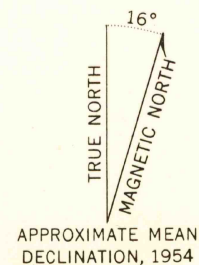

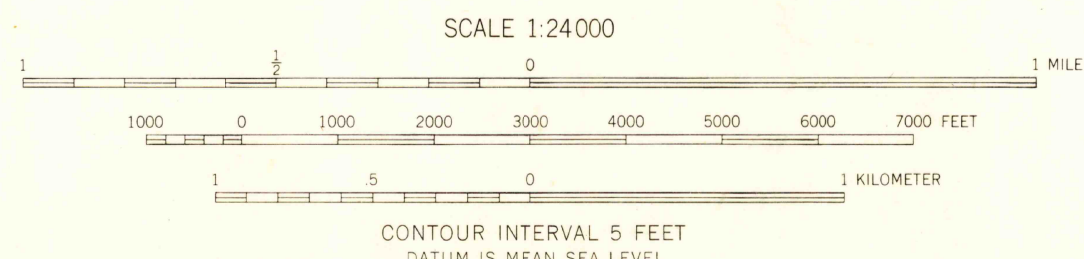
Topography by planetable surveys 1932. Culture and drainage revised from aerial photographs taken 1950. Field check and partial contour revision 1954.
