move the projection lines 2 meters south and

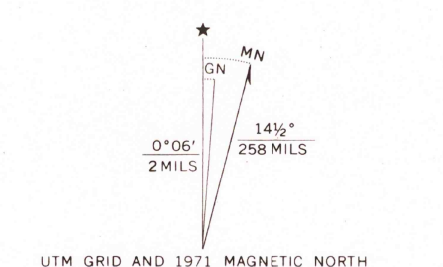
80 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks

are subject to controlled inundation

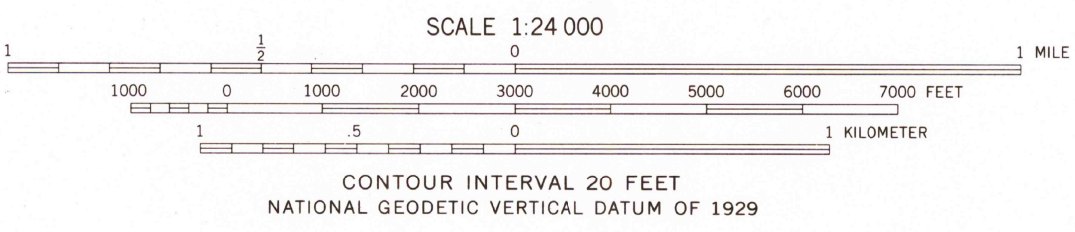
