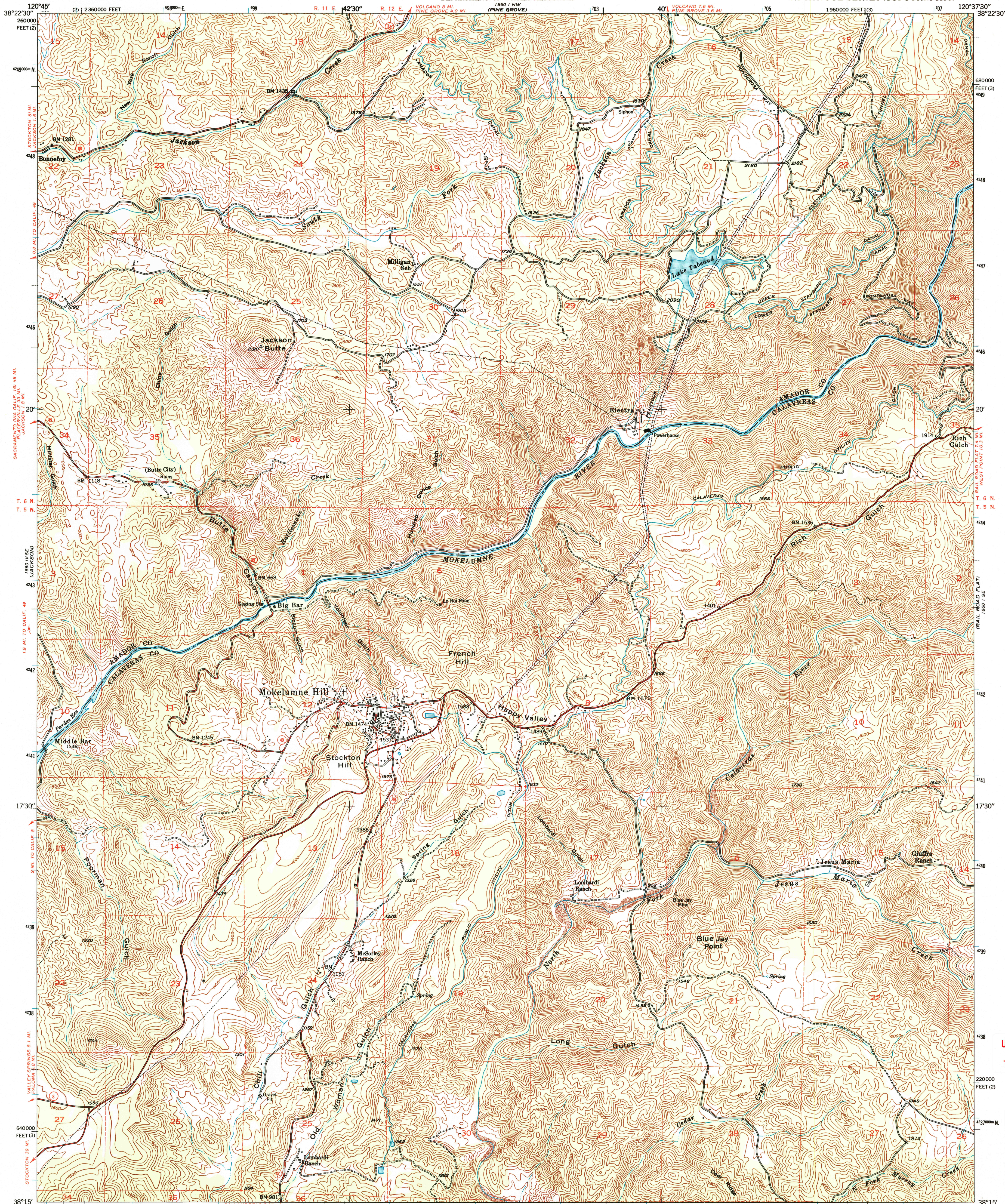

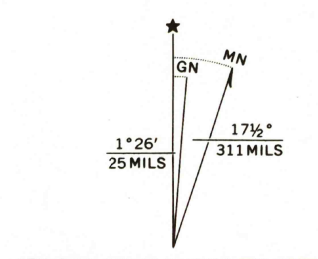

zones 2 and 3

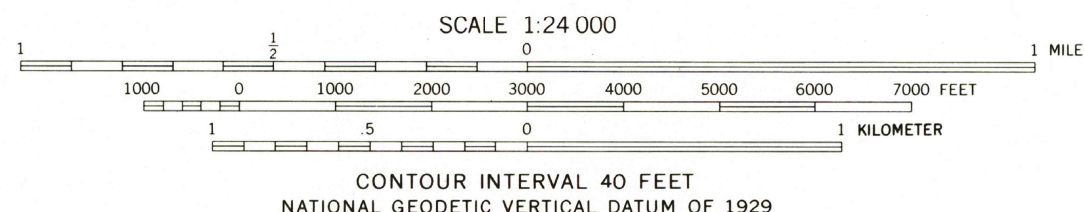
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,
