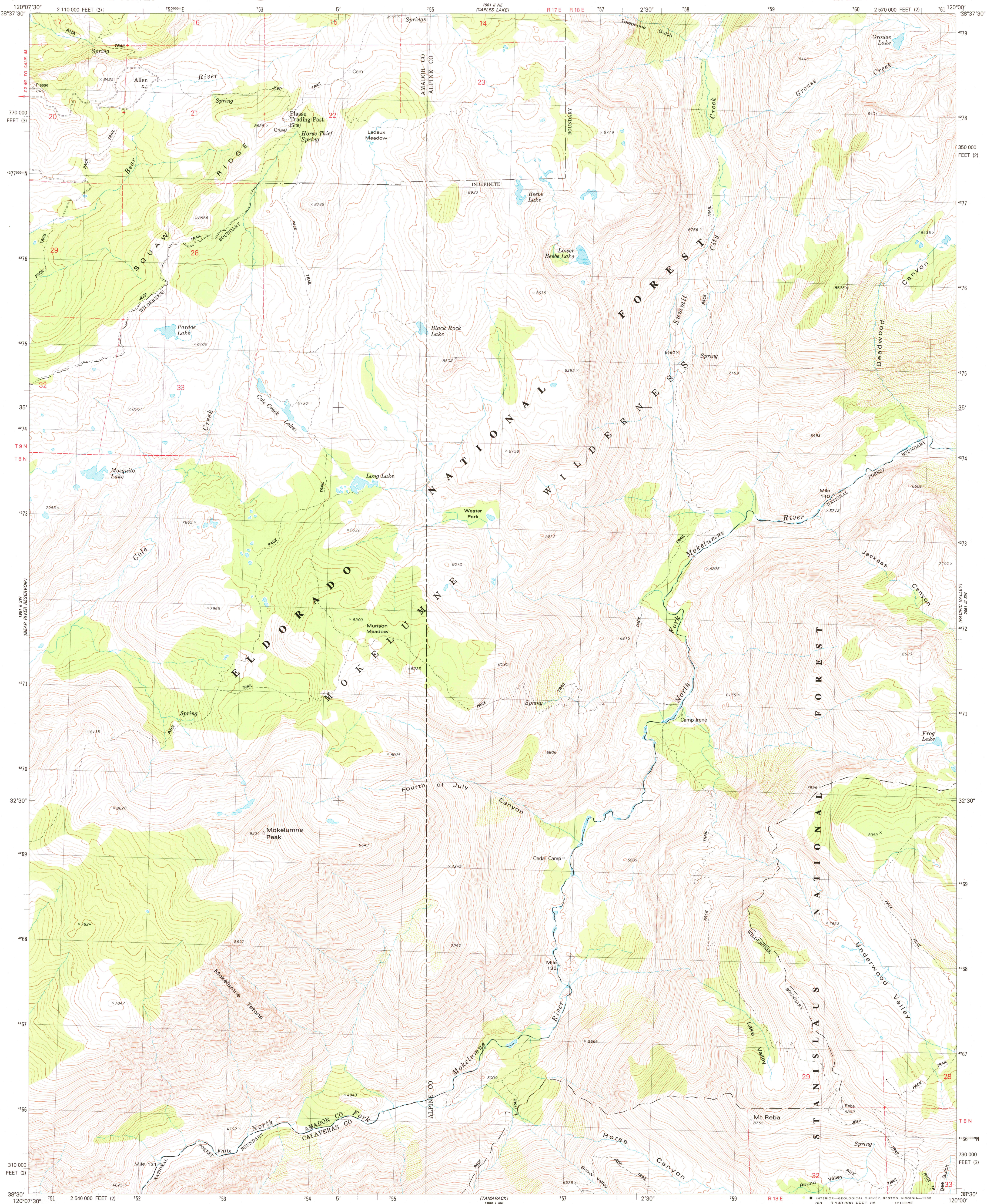
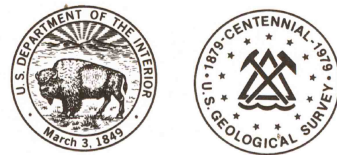

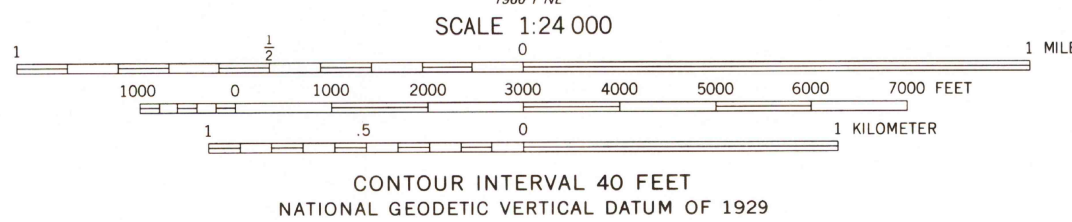
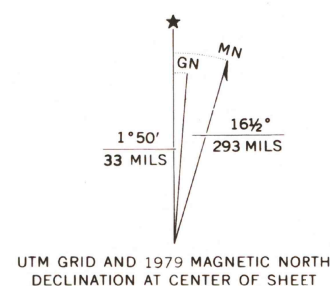
Projection: California coordinate system, zone 2 (Lambert conformal conic)
